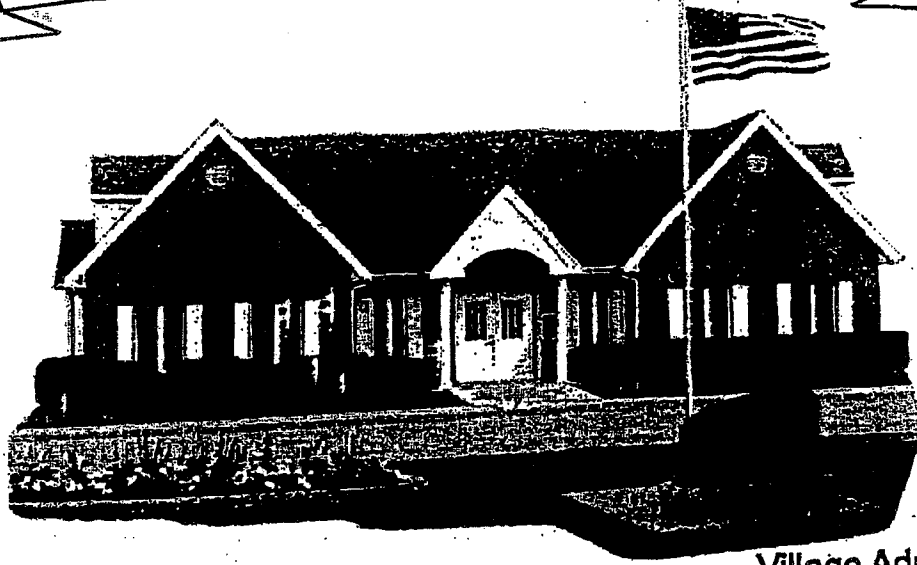


RE: Aqua Illinois – University Park Wastewater Plant Expansion

Dear Ms. Thompson:

Aqua Illinois recently submitted applications to the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) and to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) for an incremental expansion of the University Park Wastewater Treatment Plant from a designed average flow of 2.17 MGD to 2.43 MGD. While the Village of Monee is not in a position to comment as to the merits of Aqua's plant expansion plans, it is important that there is sufficient capacity to serve the entire Village along with future developments that are to be located in our community. The Village of Monee officials have advised Aqua as to its present and future capacity needs. Therefore, the Village of Monee supports Aqua Illinois' plan to expand their treatment plant to provide capacity for the Village's growth and economic development.

In regard to the recommended CMAP ordinances providing for water quality protection, which are comparable to the objectives and standards of the following former Northeastern Illinois Planning Commission (NIPC) model ordinances, the Village of Monee has adopted Will County's county-wide storm water ordinance. The Village of Monee has taken steps to protect water quality while planning for growth and development that better positions our community to prosper in the years to come. Please help us reach our goals by supporting Aqua Illinois' request for an expansion to their plant.
