- Project Summary:** The project involved stabilization of 200 feet of eroding streambanks along Poplar Creek, a tributary of the Fox River in Cook County. The project is controlling streambank erosion and reducing nonpoint source pollution via streambank regarding, stone toe protection, and native vegetation planting and seeding, while protecting and enhancing habitat, ameliorating damage from peak flows, reducing peak flow velocities, and enhancing aesthetic qualities.
