**Project Summary:** A Salt Creek Education Work Strategy (EWS) was developed to assist with

the education component of the *Salt Creek Watershed Implementation Plan*. This watershed implementation plan, which was in draft form at the time the EWS was created, was used to help guide the development of the outreach and education activities. The EWS identified and prioritized the needs for education materials and technical assistance in the watershed. As the only active watershed group in the Salt Creek watershed, the SCWN assisted NIPC in developing and implementing components of the Salt Creek Education Work Strategy. The organization, built on its capacity to provide

effective outreach to local governments, and developed a positive rapport between the SCWN and the communities in which it works. The EWS developed a full suite of objectives that were identified for the watershed.

Implementation of these objectives was then conducted based on prioritized rankings and the available resources. Several manuals were developed as a result of this Salt Creek Education Strategy including the
