

Safety performance measures – 5 year rolling average

- 1. Number of fatalities
- 2. Rate of fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles traveled (VMT)
- 3. Number of serious injuries
- 4. Rate of serious injuries 100 million VMT
- 5. Number of non-motorized fatalities and serious injuries

Integration with TIP and long-range plan






IDOT 2021 fatalities target






IDOT 2021 rate of fatalities target






IDOT 2021 serious injuries target






IDOT 2021 rate of serious injuries
