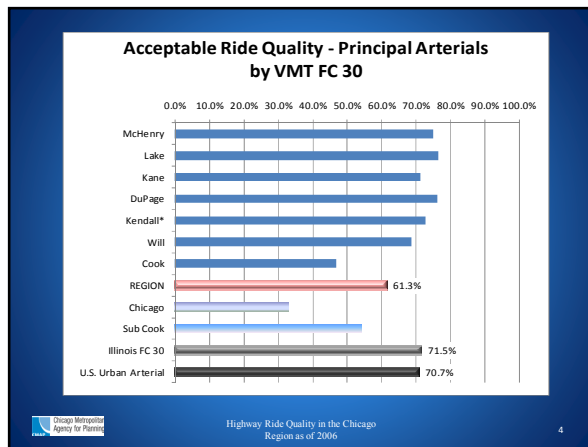
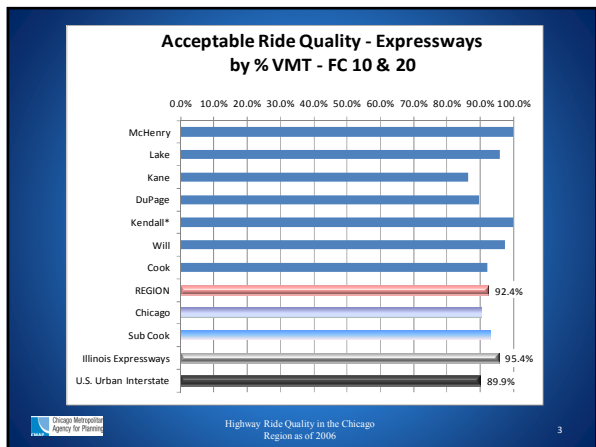

Vehicle Miles Travel (VMT)	HPMS 2003	IRIS 2006
Interstate & Urban Expressways (Functional Class 10 & 20)	89.0%	92.4%
Principal Arterials (Functional Class 30)	66.6%	61.3%
