II. Approval of Minutes – January 11, 2006 Meeting

A motion to approve the minutes of the January 11, 2006 was made by Member Hartstein and seconded by Member Michelini. It was unanimously approved.

III. Committee Reports

A. Executive Committee - Mayor Gerald R. Bennett, Chair

The Executive Committee met three weeks ago to assign tasks to various committee members. McKinsey has been working on the Executive Director search and the Executive Committee is ready to begin the process of interviews. Legal issues and applications to current organizations and RPB are being reviewed with the assistance of Mayer, Brown, Rowe, and Maw. The Executive Committee plans to meet in one month for an update on these issues.

B. Transition Committee - Nigel F. Telman, Chair

The first committee meeting was held on January 27 and Mr. Telman noted it was well attended. The discussion involved the identification and exploration of the most critical tasks to be accomplished. With the assistance of Mercer Consulting, conversations with Executive Directors and members of both NIPC and CATS have helped the committee identify issues and ensure on-going work continues. A key issue that needs immediate attention is the removal of CATS staff from the State of Illinois payroll by the end of June. The next meeting date has not been decided but a meeting announcement will be posted. Subcommittee Chair Telman emphasized input is always welcome.

C. Public Participation Committee - President Elliott Hartstein, Chair
In a meeting on February 8, 2006 the roles and responsibilities of the
committee were discussed including the main objectives of Citizen
Involvement Plan and public relations. Various approaches to the Citizen
Involvement Plan were discussed and the committee agreed it should not
be an amalgam of interest groups but representative of the people of
Northeastern Illinois. An application is being drafted to distribute to
members of the community interested in being involved. Public relations
efforts have begun with the development of talking points for use by RPB
members. A brochure is also in development, a draft was passed to the
full board and feedback requested. This committee will meet regularly
prior to all full RPB meetings. Other meetings will be scheduled in the
evening and in various locations to allow for more public participation.
Meeting notices will be posted.

Chairman Bennett added that the designation of the RPB as a pro growth or anti growth organization is not the question to be asking. Rather, establishing a diverse well represented organization that addresses all components of planning in Northeastern Illinois and integrating a proper plan for the future is the focus.

D. Planning & Priorities Committee - President Al Larson, Chair
The committee met on February 8, 2006 to discuss organization and goals.
The examination of existing long range plans has been recommended in order to build on what exists while focusing on projects and issues regional in scope. The committee seeks to further discuss the goals and vision.

IV. CATS – NIPC Updates

A. 2030 Regional Transportation Plan - Kermit Wies, Deputy for Planning

Chicago Area Transportation Study

CATS policy committee will be updating its 2030 plan in October,
releasing a draft with updated text in April to the Planning and Priorities

Committee for their review and approval. The goal is to establish the RPB

as an agency that is coordinating regional advocacy in transportation funding. The RTP update does not take place until 2010.

B. Progress Report on Co-Location - Ron Thomas, Executive Director Northeastern Illinois Planning Commission

Mr. Thomas stated that Transition Committee Chairman Telman covered a good deal of the issues to be discussed. The need for RPB support of the current funding structure was stressed. Other notes include the acknowledgment of this terrific new space and that both staffs are moved in and working well.

V. Executive Session

The Board adjourned into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing the Executive Director search. Motion to adjourn and go into Executive Session was made by Member Rupp Srch, seconded by Member Michelini and passed unanimously.

VI. Reconvene Regular Meeting

Motion to reconvene was made by Member Shea, seconded by Member Calderone, and passed unanimously.

VII. Executive Session Report - Mayor Gerald R. Bennett, Board Chair

Chairmen Bennett stated that the Executive Committee is moving along with the Executive Director search and shall conduct interviews at a decided date in a closed session in accordance with the Open Meetings Act.

Chairman Bennett opened the meeting for public comment, no comments were offered.
