The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) recently allocated \$3.92 billion in grants to help states and communities deal with

foreclosures. Visit http://www.hud.gov/nsp/ to read about the Neighborhood Stabilization Program, also described in a HUD press release.. Illinois' portion of the allocation is \$170 million. Local recipients of the Neighborhood Stabilization Program Funds recently met at CMAP to discuss the program's requirements and potential strategies for best utilizing these resources. The funds have been allocated specifically to acquire and redevelop foreclosed properties that might otherwise become abandoned and/or sources of blight. Given the limited timeframe for developing a plan and expending the funds, CMAP and its partners are seeking to facilitate information sharing among the grantees, which will be key to leveraging additional assistance and maximizing impact.
