Re: Scoring FY 2010 UWP Discretionary Projects

As discussed at the UWP meeting on March 10, please find the attached spreadsheet with the UWP competitive proposals for FY 2010. Use this spreadsheet to score these projects with a "3", "2", or "1", with "3" being the highest score.

We have eight voting bodies on the UWP Committee, so each of the following agencies should submit one scoring sheet:

- 1) The City of Chicago, 2) CTA, 3) Metra, 4) Pace, 5) CMAP, 6) RTA, 7) the Regional Council of Mayors representative, and 8) County representative.

Please do not score your own agency's submitted projects. In addition, you need not distribute your number of "3", "2" and "1" votes perfectly evenly across the projects. Please use your own judgment based on the following criteria:

- 1) The quality of the project's proposal.
- 2) The relative agency priority ranking, as discussed in Tuesday's meeting.
- 3) Our [approved list of regional focus areas](#) for the discretionary program. These remain as follows:
 1. Integration of Transportation and Land Use Planning
 2. Congestion Relief (Multi-Modal) (Management, Research and Analysis)
 3. Environmental Impacts of Transportation Decisions
 4. Development of Comprehensive Regional Plan
 5. Transportation's Role in Economic and Community Development

6. Jobs-Housing-Transportation Planning
7. Transportation Issues for Seniors and People with Disabilities
8. Financing the Transportation System
9. Public Involvement in Transportation and Comprehensive Planning
10. Providing Technical Assistance
