The North Central Council of Mayors is requesting advance funding for our FY 2010 STP program in the amount of \$844,000.

The Village of Melrose Park and the City of Northlake are requesting advance funding for these projects which have recently received additional stimulus "left-over" funds, of which the remainder will be funded by the STP-L program. The Village of Westchester is requesting advance funding to resurface a small portion of Gardner Road.

The Village of Westchester would like to resurface this portion of Gardner Road which has received additional monies for resurfacing through another program. These funds would serve to complete resurfacing of the entire portion of the roadway as opposed to only select increments. This project (TIP 04-10-0008) is set for the June 2010 letting at a total cost of \$355,000 for Construction and Construction Engineering. Currently, we need \$284,000 in federal dollars over our mark to accomplish this project.

The Village of Melrose Park would like to reconstruct Broadway Avenue which serves as a vital industrial, commercial, and residential corridor for the village and neighboring communities. This project (TIP 04-09-0034) is set for the June 2010 letting at a total cost of \$1,100,000 for Construction and Construction Engineering. Currently, we need \$440,000 in federal dollars over our mark to accomplish this crucial project.

The City of Northlake would like to resurface Armitage Avenue which serves as a critical commercial and residential corridor for the City. This project (TIP 04-08-0025) is also set for the June 2010 letting at a total cost of \$702,000 for Construction and Construction Engineering. Currently we need \$120,000 in federal dollars over our mark to accomplish this crucial project.
