Re: Regional Vision Development

This memo summarizes the themes created by the CMAP working committees during spring and summer 2007 to support the development of a regional vision. Each committee has reviewed the goals and objectives from the 2040 Regional Framework Plan and 2030 Regional Transportation Plan, identified goals and objectives that are specifically relevant to the committee's focus, and identified the major themes within these goals which should be included in the regional vision.

The table below summarizes the results of this process and organizes the themes identified by each working committee. Fourteen major themes have been identified from the committees' work. Staff has grouped similar themes from different working committees together in order to have a manageable number of major themes for the vision development process.
