LOCAL TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE (LTA) PROGRAM

 Funded through federal Partnership for Sustainable Communities, joint DOT-HUD-EPA program







- CMAP received \$4.25 million from HUD, leveraged by \$6 million in other sources
- Purpose: implement GO TO 2040 plan through direct staff assistance to municipalities, counties, non-profits / NGOs
- First projects being completed in Spring 2012.

LTA PROJECTS THROUGHOUT THE REGION

- 64 current projects chosen from 220 proposals from 130 applicants
- Geographically balanced
- Major project types:
 - Comprehensive plans
 - Revisions to zoning or other ordinances
 - Small-area plans
 - Topic-specific projects
 water, housing,
 parking, others



CURRENT PROJECT ACTIVITY

50 Projects Initiated

- Completed:

STAFF ASSISTANCE VS. GRANT ASSISTANCE

- Grant assistance projects will comprise about half of newly initiated projects
- Most projects with an active transportation component will be grant assistance projects

ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS

- Antioch: Greenway Corridor Plan
- Downers Grove: Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan
- Elgin: Sidewalk Gap and Transit Stop Study
- Fox Lake: Bikeway and Greenway Plan
- Plainfield: Downtown Transportation Plan
- Wheeling: Active Transportation Plan

Many other upcoming projects will include an active transportation component

NEXT LTA CALL FOR PROJECTS

- Call for Projects anticipated for May 9, 2012
- Deadline for applications anticipated for August 1, 2012
- Project Selections anticipated for October 2012

Note: Selection process is expected to be more competitive for this round; creative projects and/or creative partnerships may receive a better reception

LTA SYMPOSIUM
