As part of next plan development, CMAP is preparing an Infill and TOD Snapshot, which will provide an overview of existing conditions and trends in infill and TOD in the region. Staff will present findings, including an evaluation of progress towards development targets established in the 2014 update of GO TO 2040, and an examination of additional indicators of infill (such as changes in population, households, density, and housing units) throughout the region, as well as in transit-served areas.

6.0 Integrating stormwater management into comprehensive plans, Kate Evasic, CMAP Staff

Localized flooding is a common concern among the region's municipalities, yet many communities lack the resources to fully understand the problems they face or identify strategies to address flooding issues. In order to better integrate stormwater management into decisions about land use and development, CMAP is developing a spatial approach to identify potential flood problem and corresponding opportunity areas to address flooding using green infrastructure solutions. Evasic will provide an update on the evolving approach.
