# 4.0 ON TO 2050: Tax policy and land use trends strategy paper – Lindsay Hollander, CMAP Staff

GO TO 2040 recognized that tax policy plays a significant role in the region's economic growth and development patterns. For ON TO 2050, CMAP staff have been continuing to investigate this nexus. CMAP staff will present the draft strategy paper, which focuses on how communities provide municipal services and infrastructure to an array of land uses.
