Ultimately, Foresight will produce a strategy paper highlighting the role and strategies CMAP should pursue in the next plan. Dan will briefly present on current ideas around scope topics.

As part of ON TO 2050 development, CMAP is preparing a Local Food Snapshot, which will provide an overview of trends in food production, the number and characteristics of farms, the value of agricultural products sold in the region, and recent and ongoing activities in the local food policy area. Brian will present the preliminary findings of the research.

- 7.0 ON TO 2050: Natural Resources Snapshot Scope – Kristin Ihnchak, CMAP Staff As part of ON TO 2050 development, CMAP is preparing a Natural Resources Snapshot, which will provide an overview of key trends impacting natural resources in the region. Staff will present the scope of work for this analysis. ACTION REQUESTED: Discussion
- 8.0 ON TO 2050: Water Strategy Paper: Initial Findings– Jason Navota, CMAP Staff Water 2050 and GO TO 2040 recognized the water supply, water quality, and wastewater planning challenges facing the region and emphasized demand management and resource protection strategies. CMAP is exploring new approaches to water resource planning as part of the development of the next plan. Jason will present an initial scan of the existing policy framework and some challenges facing the region. **ACTION REQUESTED: Discussion**
- 9.0 ON TO 2050: Stormwater and Flooding Strategy Paper: Scope – Nora Beck, CMAP Staff GO TO 2040 recognized stormwater management and flooding challenges facing the region and recommended the integration of land use policies and site planning with water resources. In addition to the water strategy paper, CMAP is exploring new approaches to stormwater management as it relates to flooding as part of the development of the next plan. Nora will present a draft scope for a stormwater strategy paper to explore this topic further in ON TO 2050. ACTION REQUESTED: Discussion
