- 5.0 Midlothian 147th Street Corridor Plan – Tony Manno, CMAP staff**
The Village of Midlothian, in partnership with the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP), Active Transportation Alliance, and Center for Neighborhood Technology (CNT), completed a plan of action for [147th Street](#) between Cicero Avenue and Kedzie Avenue to identify potential stormwater management and pedestrian improvements. Green infrastructure concepts were developed and pedestrian improvements were identified for specific locations along the corridor, and CMAP staff will present the final concepts to the ENR Committee.

The Village of Richton Park and CMAP, with assistance from Conservation Design Forum and Geosyntec, are developing a [master plan](#) for the west side of the community that integrates development with natural resource protection and stormwater management. The study area extends along Sauk Trail from I-57 to the east and Ridgeland Avenue to the west. The team has developed a concept plan for near- and long-term development that delineates the green infrastructure network and proposed development areas. CMAP will present the analysis, concept plans, and next steps to the ENR committee.
