Through the LTA program, CMAP is assisting McHenry and Lake Counties, local governments, and organizations to create a corridor plan for the Fox River to improve water quality, multi-modal transportation access, recreation and open space, and river-related commerce. The planning area spans eight communities, conservation areas, forest preserves, and parks over a distance of 11 miles and builds on the LTA Fox River Corridor Plan for the Villages of 9:30 a.m.
