


## What is PROWAG? - Proposed guidelines designed to ensure accessibility for all pedestrians in the public right-of-way, including those with mobility impairments. -Per the ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) and where federally funded, the ABA (Architectural Barriers Act) and the Rehabilitation Act.

## What is PROWAG? -PROWAG was developed by the U.S. Access Board (originally named the Architectural and Transportation Barriers Compliance Board). -Public Rights-of-Way Access Advisory Committee (PROWAAC). -Proposed rulemaking has been published as an appendix in the Federal Register. -Previous drafts were released in 2002 and 2005, both opened for public comment. What is covered?















## What's Next? -Public commentary period is currently open. -Comments due November 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2011. (www.regulations.gov) -Public hearings in Dallas and Washington, D.C. -When finalized, requirements will apply to new construction or altered portions of the public right-of-way.
