3.1 GO TO 2040 Plan

Deborah Fagan will give the Task Force an overview and assessment of DuPage County's bike parking project – background, implementation, and lessons learned. SUGGESTED ACTION: Information.

3.3 **Cook County Communities Putting Prevention to Work (CPPW)**

Paul Lippens, Cook County Complete Streets Coordinator at Active Transportation Alliance will give the Task Force an overview of the CPPW grant and the effort to develop a plan for implementation of a Complete Streets policy in Cook County. SUGGESTED ACTION: Information and discussion.

3.4 **CMAP Training – Bicycle and Pedestrian Planning**

CMAP has contracted with Active Transportation Alliance to deliver the Safe Routes to School National Course in eight communities around the region. Staff will update the Task Force on the progress of these workshops. In addition, CMAP is co-sponsoring the two-d ay FHWA course, *Designing for Pedestrian Safety*. Staff will give details on these training opportunities. SUGGESTED ACTION: *Information*

3.5 Eisenhower Expansion Project – Eisenhower Regional Trail

IDOT has initiated planning for improvements to the Eisenhower Expressway (I-290) from Cicero Avenue in the City of Chicago to Mannheim Road (U.S. 12/20/45) in the Village of Hillside (see the IDOT website: <u>http://www.eisenhowerexpressway.com/</u>). The Task Force will discuss and if appropriate vote on a resolution calling for "the analysis of the potential for a major new off-road trail connecting to the Illinois Prairie Path and other local bikeways within the study corridor." SUGGESTED ACTION: *Information, discussion, and approval.*

4.1 Illinois Safe Routes to School

4.2 Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program

4.3 Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program (CMAQ)

4.4 Pedestrians' right-of-way at crosswalks (Public Act 096-1165)

The Task Force will discuss issues and concerns with implementing Public Act 096-1165, which requires drivers to "stop and yield the right-of-way" to pedestrians in a crosswalk. Task Force members and stakeholders in the region would like to discuss education and awareness strategies, opportunities, and responsibilities, timeframes for changes to signage, and any broader policy implications resulting from this change in state law.
