The bike-ped methodology review group has met once since the last Task Force meeting. The group reviewed existing ranking methodologies. Minor to moderate changes were proposed for the bike facilities ranking methodology, while substantial changes were identified as desirable for the pedestrian project ranking method. Staff will continue work on this project. Any changes in ranking procedures will be applied to FY 2010 and succeeding year projects.
