The North Shore Council of Mayors respectfully requests that the Council of Mayors Executive Committee approve our request for advanced funding of **\$112,612** in federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) dollars. The request is for Skokie's Skokie Boulevard at Old Orchard Road Intersection Improvement project (TIP # 02-00-0103). The Council of Mayors Executive Committee has already approved \$3,753,741 in advanced funding for the project. The project was let in January and came bids came in above engineering estimates. Consequently, the additional \$112,612 in STP funding will offset part of the higher cost.

The improvement of the Skokie Boulevard/Old Orchard Road Intersection project consists of resurfacing, rehabilitating and reconstructing the roadway; providing separate storm sewer detention in a combined sewer region; constructing storm sewer and water main; and installing roadway lighting and a new traffic signal. The proposed intersection provides dual left turn lanes from northbound Skokie Boulevard to westbound Old Orchard Road and a right turn lane from eastbound Old Orchard Road to southbound Skokie Boulevard. The improvement meets the needs identified in Phase I to increase the lane capacity, providing a benefit for users of local businesses such as the Old Orchard Shopping Center and a regional benefit for traffic to and from the I-94 Edens Expressway.

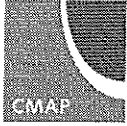
