4.0 Transportation Consent Agenda: Semi-Annual GO TO 2040/TIP Conformity Analysis & TIP Amendment

A conformity analysis of GO TO 2040 and the FFY 2014-2019 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and a proposed TIP amendment were released for public comment on January 16, 2015. The public comment period ended February 16, 2015. No comments on the conformity analysis or TIP amendment were received. Thirteen project changes make up the proposed amendment. One project's scope of work was changed; five projects were brought into the TIP; one project was moved out of the TIP; and six projects changed their completion years, crossing an analysis year. A memo detailing the proposed amendment and the results of the conformity analysis is attached, and a project report is available on the web.

5.0 Update on Illinois 53/120 Corridor Land Use Plan

The Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) is working with Lake County and communities on a **corridor land use plan for Illinois Route 53 and Illinois Route 120**, as recommended by a Blue Ribbon Advisory Council of the Illinois Tollway. This corridor planning process is engaging municipalities to plan for the potential market-driven development that can result from such a major transportation infrastructure investment, as well as the potential impact on quality of life and the environment. Staff will provide an update on progress on the project.

6.0 Economic Valuation of the Chicago Wilderness Green Infrastructure Vision

Through its partnership with Chicago Wilderness, CMAP developed a map of regionally important conservation lands known as the Green Infrastructure Vision (GIV). This vision plays an important part in GO TO 2040. CMAP recently produced a **follow-up report estimating the economic benefits** associated with preserving the lands identified in the GIV. Staff will provide an overview of the report's findings.

1.0 Call to Order

Elliot Hartstein called the meeting to order at 8:05 AM and asked committee members to introduce themselves.

2.0 Agenda Changes and Announcements

There were no agenda changes or announcements.

3.0 Approval of Minutes – October 8, 2014

A motion was made to approve the minutes of the October 8, 2014 meeting. All in favor, the motion carried.

4.0 Cook County Long Range Transportation Plan

Maria Choca-Urban presented on the planning process and results thus far in the Cook County Long-Range Transportation Plan process. The presentation highlighted the four transportation, funding, and investment scenarios developed through the process. Elliot Hartstein asked how the Service Boards had been involved. Maria described the two committees that have been used for feedback and comment on the plan. The Advisory Committee has representatives from the Councils of Government and civic organizations. The Program Committee includes representation from transportation agencies. She also noted there has been an extensive stakeholder and public outreach process for the plan. Ed Paesel noted that the Cook County Department of Transportation and Highways has been investing in infrastructure to attract economic development and support existing businesses.

5.0 Reorienting State and Regional Economic Development

Lindsay Hollander presented CMAP's recent report, Reorienting State and Regional Economic Development: Challenges and Opportunities for Metropolitan Chicago. The report is a follow-up to a report on national best practices in regional economic development. The new report identified opportunities to reorient current ED practices around four strategies: Strategic and prioritized investment of resources, coordinated workforce development initiatives, monitoring and evaluation of policies, and competing in a global marketplace. Elliot Hartstein asked if standards for incentives and/or standards for clawbacks and repayment were discussed in the report. Lindsay noted that those topics were discussed as part of CMAP's local economic development incentives report. Frank Beal asked what CMAP's role in encouraging regional coordination of Economic Development is, beyond analysis. Lindsay indicated that this is a core topic of discussion, and noted the report's recommendations on competing in a global marketplace. Pat Carey noted that this is major topic of discussion at CMAP's Economic Development Committee and is an ongoing question.

6.0 Regional Intelligent Transportation Systems Architecture Update

Claire Bozic presented on the proposed Regional Intelligent Transportation Systems Architecture Update. Claire described the process thus far, and the intent to identify changes to the regional ITS infrastructure to ensure that it reflects expected ITS development over the next 15 years. She requested committee approval of the architecture update. A motion was offered by Mike Connelly, seconded by Al Larson, and approved.

7.0 State Legislative Update

Gordon Smith presented CMAP's revised State Legislative Framework and Agenda. He noted that the Framework document was formerly the State Legislative Principles document. He described the 6 areas of focus in the document and noted that the board would review and approve both documents at their meeting later on January 14th, 2015. Ed Paesel asked how CMAP is coordinating the various transportation and infrastructure funding initiatives currently proposed, like FUND 2040, TFIC, and Transit Future. Gordon noted that FUND 2040 would likely be part of a broader package of transportation funding initiatives, and that CMAP has to put our proposal forward. The General Assembly will coordinate. Sheri Cohen asked for more specifics about broadening the sales tax base. Gordon responded that, per the Regional Tax Policy Task Force, the framework refers to broadening the sales tax base. Pat Carey indicated that he was glad to see a proactive approach and asked how we see CMAP recommendations playing out given political changes. Gordon indicated that the Governor's Transition Team Report contained many CMAP policies. At the General Assembly level, CMAP has been working with legislators on tax reform and sees opportunities. John Noak asked if CMAP should stay with an 8 cent MFT increase request. Gordon noted that is a recommendation of GO TO 2040. A final committee member asked if the Framework and Agenda give the agency flexibility. Gordon noted that this is the intent of the documents. Frank Beal noted that it was good to see that the governor's transition report has so many CMAP policies.

8.0 Other Business

There was no other business.

9.0 Public Comment

There was no public comment.

10.0 **Next Meeting**

The Regional Coordinating Committee meets next on March 11, 2015.



Re: Semi-Annual GO TO 2040/TIP Conformity Analysis & TIP Amendments

In accordance with the biannual conformity analysis policy CMAP staff asked programmers to submit changes, additions, or deletions to non-exempt projects for inclusion in the regional air quality analysis of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and GO TO 2040. Of the changes requested, thirteen (13) projects require air quality conformity analysis. Below is a summary of the types of requested changes.



If the TIP amendments are approved, five new non-exempt projects will be included in the TIP. These types of projects are included in the conformity analysis because funding for phases beyond preliminary engineering has been identified in the TIP. Non-exempt and exempt tested projects with only preliminary engineering funding are exempt from conformity analysis. The new projects are:

- TIP ID 07-96-0013: Extending Joe Orr Rd from Burnham to the Indiana/Illinois state line.
- TIP ID 09-00-0033: Extending Bliss/Fabyan Rd.
- TIP ID 09-99-0102: Building the La Fox Rd Bypass.
- TIP ID 12-00-0035: A new bridge over the DesPlaines River and roadway alignment of the Caton-Bruce corridor from west of US 30 to IL 7 159th St.
- TIP ID 12-15-0002: Adding lanes to Bell Rd from 131st St to IL 7 159th St, while omitting the intersections of 151st St and 143rd St.

A request to remove all funding from the active years of the TIP for one project was received. This project will no longer be included in the conformity determination. The project being removed from the conformity determination is:

• TIP ID 08-95-0024: Adding lanes on IL 83 from 31st St to I-55.

Scope changes have been requested for one existing project. The scope of a project is determined by the **work types** associated with the project.

- Non-exempt work types may affect air quality and must be tested for conformity. Examples of non-exempt work types are adding lanes to a road, an interchange expansion, signal timing and the major expansion of bus route service.
- Exempt tested work types do not require an air quality conformity analysis, but the region has chosen to include the impacts of projects including these work types in the travel demand model. Exempt tested projects include new commuter parking lots, rolling stock replacement, and road reconstruction with lane widening to standard (e.g., 10 feet to 12 feet).
- Exempt work types do not require an air quality conformity analysis. Examples of exempt work types are intersection improvements and rail station modernization.

The project for which a scope change has been requested is:

• TIP ID 10-09-0037: Reconstruction of the interchange at US 41 Skokie Highway and IL 176, including adding an auxiliary lane on the north/south component and an additional lane on IL 176 from IL 43 to the UP North line RR on the east/west portion.

The completion year indicates when a project is anticipated to be in service to users. The conformity analysis is conducted for selected analysis years between now and 2040. The analysis years are currently 2015, 2025, 2030 and 2040. If a change in completion year results in moving a project across an analysis year, the project must be included in a new conformity analysis. Sponsors indicated that several projects have updated completion years; six of those crossed an analysis year.

- TIP ID **07-11-0004**: Grade separation of US 30 Lincoln Highway at Canadian National RR, the sponsor has requested moving the completion year from 2015 to 2017.
- TIP ID 08-00-0010: Adding lanes on IL 56 Butterfield Rd from IL 59 to Naperville Rd, the sponsor has requested moving the completion year from 2014 to 2016.
- TIP ID **08-11-0001**: Grade separation of US 34 Ogden Ave at Canadian National RR, the sponsor has requested moving the completion year from 2015 to 2018.

- TIP ID 09-96-0018: Channelization of Stearns Rd at Randall Rd, the sponsor has requested moving the completion year from 2014 to 2017.
- TIP ID 12-06-0041: An extension of 143rd Street from IL 126 to Steiner Road, the sponsor has requested moving the completion year from 2014 to 2017.
- TIP ID 18-11-0046: A new station along the UP North Railroad at Peterson Ave and Ridge Ave, the sponsor has requested moving the completion year from 2015 to 2016.

Each TIP ID includes a hyperlink to the TIP database for further current project information. Changes being made to the project are shown in the attached report.

TIP projects are also viewable in a map format. The TIP map is available at http://www.cmap.illinois.gov/programs-and-resources/tip/tip-data/tip-map.

The 2015, 2025, 2030, and 2040 highway and transit networks were coded to include the project changes listed in the "Non-Exempt Projects Requiring Conformity Determination" report. The regional travel demand model was run using the updated networks. The resultant vehicle miles traveled (VMT) by vehicle class, speed, time of day, and facility type were entered into US Environmental Protection Agency's MOVES model. The model generated on-road emission estimates for each precursor or direct pollutant in each analysis year.

For ozone precursors volatile organic compounds (VOC) and nitrogen oxides (NOx), the resulting emissions inventories estimates fell below the applicable budgets for the maintenance State Implementation Plan (SIP).

Both the annual direct fine particulate (PM_{2.5}) and NOx emissions inventories are below the applicable budgets from the attainment SIP.
