


Chicago's Bike Renaissance

Mayor Emanuel's Transition Report – May 2011

- Improve street safety by reducing fatalities and crashes
- Build 100 miles of protected bike lanes
- Build bikeways that are comfortable for all ages and abilities
- Introduce a citywide bike share system





Four Types of Cyclists

Streets for Cycling Plan 2020 Citywide plan creating a world-class network of bike facilities that are safe and comfortable for all Chicagoans • Released in 2012 • Over 600-mile network of Neighborhood Bike Routes, Crosstown Bike Routes, and Spoke Routes • Bike facility within ½ mile of every Chicagoan Chicago Streets for Cycling Plan 2020

2013 Summary

- 31 miles of new and restriped bikeways
- Including 19 miles of barrier and buffer protected bike lanes
- 9 miles of existing bikeways restriped
- Chicago's first neighborhood greenway
- Launch of DIVVY Bikeshare

Since May 2011...

- 56.5 miles of protected bike lanes
- 2 miles of neighborhood greenways



Barrier Protected Bike Lanes

- 4 miles installed in 2013
- 16 miles installed since May 2011









Milwaukee Ave Spoke Route

Milwaukee Ave is Chicago's most heavily bicycled street. More than 6,000 bicyclists per day ride Milwaukee Ave throughout most of the year, and bicyclists represent over 40% of peak hour traffic.


- Continuous bikeway between Kinzie and Elston
- Bicycle signal at Elston
- Bike boxes at Kinzie, Grand, and Ogden
- Green pavement markings
- Bike passing lanes over the Ohio Feeder Ramp
- Solar lights in the buffer protected bike lanes
- Installation of a bike corral near Ogden Avenu Addition of 4 Divvy Stations












Buffer Protected Bike Lanes 15 miles installed in 2013 40.5 miles installed since May 2011







Divvy Bike Share...

- A new transit system for Chicago
- Ideal for short trips and commutes
- Allows you to pick up a bike at any station and return it to any other
- Available 24/7 year-round









Affordable for the User

- \$75 Annual Membership = \$.20/day
- \$7 24-Hour Membership
- First 30 minutes of each ride are free



DIVVY to Date (since 6/28/13)

- 1,500,000 trips
 - 895,000 member trips
 - 605,000 24-hour trips
- 22,000 annual members
- 222,000 24-hour passes
- 3,315,000 miles traveled
