## 3.0 Local and Regional Planning

## 3.1 GO TO 2040 Update (CMAP staff)

As required under MAP-21, staff has been in the process of updating the GO TO 2040 plan since the summer of 2013. Staff has prepared a <u>draft plan update</u> consisting of a summary document and a series of appendices that describe each of the key elements of the project in technical detail. Plan recommendations were not changed. Staff anticipates releasing the draft for public comment on June 13. Outreach meetings have been <u>scheduled across the region</u> through the end of the public comment period on August 1. Staff anticipates adoption of the final plan update at the October meetings of the Board and MPO Policy Committee.

## 3.2 City of Chicago – Streets for Cycling Plan 2020 Update

## 3.3 UIC Multimodal Transportation Plan and Chicago Lighthouse Workshop

With help from the Active Transportation Alliance, CMAP's Local Technical Assistance program is working with the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) to undertake an interactive, community-based process for gathering public input. This input will contribute to the LTA project, currently underway, to create a multimodal transportation plan for UIC. CMAP staff (Lindsay Bayley) will present on the outreach and engagement efforts used in the early stages of the project to collect data
