5.0 Active Program Management

Utilizing Active Program Management over the last few years, the region's unobligated CMAQ balance has decreased significantly. Tracking of project status toward implementation has improved and the programmed projects are moving forward. As the unobligated balance decreases, the ability to approve cost increases, schedule changes, and reinstatement of deferred

funds decreases. Options to best accommodate these requests and keep projects moving forward will be explored. ACTION REQUESTED: Discussion

6.0 Project Changes

6.1 Aurora - Station Blvd Extension to IL 59 Commuter Parking Lot (TIP ID 09-14-0002)

The sponsor is requesting a scope change to address comments from BNSF, Metra and Pace received during phase 2 engineering. The requested scope change has resulted in the sponsor requesting an additional \$1,481,000 federal (\$1,635,000 total) for the construction phase, which is programmed in FFY 2015 and is targeting the April 2015 state letting. This request was tabled at the December 18, 2014 meeting.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested scope change and cost increase.

6.2 IDOT – IL 59 at W. Bartlett Rd (TIP ID 03-12-0002)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$320,000 federal (\$400,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2015 as a result of the availability of 75% design updated cost estimates based on detailed quantity calculations and current bid tab pricing. Construction funds are currently deferred and the project is targeting the April 2015 state letting. This request was tabled at the December 18, 2014 meeting. ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested cost increase and reinstatement of deferred funds.

6.3 CDOT – State/Lake Station (Loop Elevated) (TIP ID 01-02-0030)

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to move \$4,000,000 federal for Phase 2 Engineering currently programmed in FFY 2017 to FFY 2015.

ACTION REQUESTED: Consideration of the requested schedule change.

6.4 Lake County – Washington St. Bike Path (sidepath) (TIP ID 10-10-0002)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$17,000 federal (\$19,750 total), a transfer of \$50,182 federal (\$62,728 total) from Phase 1 Engineering, and a transfer of \$14,112 federal (\$17,640 total) from Phase 2 Engineering to Construction in FFY 2014 due to a higher than estimated bid.

ACTION REQUESTED: Consideration of the requested cost increase and transfers.

6.5 Lake County DOT – US 12/Rand Road at Ela Road (TIP ID 10-02-0007)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$95,000 federal (\$119,000 total) for construction in FFY 2015 due to accommodating Complete Streets in the pre-final plans. The project is targeting the April 2015 state letting.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested cost increase.

6.6 IDOT – I-55 Bus on Shoulders Support (TIP ID 01-09-0034)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$480,000 federal (\$600,000 total) for an additional year of shoulder sweeping on I-55. If approved, the increase would be processed as an amendment to the contract previously authorized in FFY 2013. Additionally, prior federal authorizations for deck rehabilitation, shoulder repair, and shoulder sweeping were authorized at a 90/10 share. Although the total cost of these previously authorized phases was less than programmed, an increase of \$128,000 federal is required to cover the over-authorizations.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested cost increases.

6.7 Homer Glen – Homer Glen community Trail – South Extension (TIP ID 12-12-0002)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$48,000 federal (\$60,000 total) for Phase 2 Engineering in FFY 2014 in order to purchase unanticipated Wetland Bank credits. Pre-final plans are under review at IDOT and the project is targeting the June 2015 state letting. ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested cost increase.

6.8 Kane County – Kirk Road at Douglas Road (TIP ID 09-08-0002)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$151,590 federal (\$172,587 total) for construction in FFY2014 due to bids being higher than the engineer's estimate.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested cost increase.

- 6.9 DuPage County DOT 55th St/CH 35 from Dunham Rd to Clarendon Hills Rd and 55th St at Main St (TIP ID 08-12-0004) The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$130,000 federal (\$163,000 total) for Phase 2 Engineering in FFY 2015, \$297,000 federal (\$371,000 total) for ROW in FFY 2015 and \$1,306,000 federal (\$1,632,000 total) for Construction/CE in FFY 2016 based on the final Phase 1 cost estimates. ACTION REQUESTED: Consideration of the requested cost increase.
- 6.10 DuPage County DOT Fabyan Parkway/Washington St., @ IL Route 83 (Roosevelt Road) (TIP ID 08-12-0006) The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$54,000 federal (\$67,000 total) for construction in FFY 2015. The project was let on January 30, 2015 and the low bid exceed the engineer's estimate.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested cost increase.

6.11 Lincolnwood - Touhy Av Overpass (Skokie Valley Bike Trail) (TIP ID 02-12-0003)

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$17,000 federal (\$22,000 total) for Phase 1 Engineering, which was authorized in FFY 2014, \$143,000 federal (\$179,000 total) for Phase 2 Engineering in FFY 2015 and \$1,923,000 federal (\$2,404,000 total) for Construction in FFY 2016 based on Phase 1 Engineering estimates. Funds for ENG2 and Construction are currently deferred. Reinstatement of ENG2 funds will be considered when Phase 1 Design Approval has been granted and the locally executed agreements are forwarded to IDOT Central Office for execution.

ACTION REQUESTED: Consideration of the requested cost increase.

6.12 Park Forest - Bicycle Lanes and Way-Finding Signs on Lakewood Blv, Indianwood Blv, Orchard Dr and Blackhawk Dr (TIP ID 07-14-0009)

The sponsor is requesting a scope change to exclude Indianwood Blvd and Orchard Dr. from the project, and add Westwood Dr., Wildwood Dr. and Shabbona Dr. to the project. The requested changes result in a cost increase of \$8,586 federal (\$10,733 total) for construction in FFY 2015.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of the requested scope change and consideration of the requested cost increase.

6.13 Kane County DOT – Fabyan Parkway at Kaneville Rd. (TIP ID 09-12-0006)

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to move \$1,083,100 federal construction funds currently programmed in FFY 2016 into FFY 2015. The project is targeting the June 2015 state letting. Construction was initially programmed in FFY 16 during the 2012 application cycle.

ACTION REQUESTED: Consideration of the requested schedule change.

6.14 Administrative Modifications

Staff completed five administrative modifications, as described in the attached CMAQ Project Change Requests memo.

Romeoville – 135th Street and New Ave Metra Parking and Platforms (SW Quadrant) (TIP ID 12-10-0001)

The sponsor requested reinstatement of \$440,000 federal CMAQ funding for Phase 2 Engineering. Phase 1 design approval was granted on September 29, 2014 and readiness was demonstrated for Phase 2. Staff completed the reinstatement as an administrative modification.

FPD of Will County – DuPage River Trail – Segment 5 (TIP ID 12-12-0001)

The sponsor requested reinstatement of \$68,000 federal CMAQ funding for Phase 2 Engineering. Phase 1 design approval was granted on December 11, 2014 and readiness was demonstrated for Phase 2. Staff completed the reinstatement as an administrative modification.

Kane County DOT – Huntley Road at Galligan Road (TIP ID 09-09-0010)

The sponsor requested a schedule change for the construction phase from FFY 2015 to FFY2016 due to delays with ROW acquisition. The project is currently deferred, however \$1,058,840 federal for construction was reinstated in October 2013 based on pre-final plans having been submitted in May of 2013. Construction is currently targeting the January 2016 state letting. Staff completed the schedule change as an administrative modification.

Lake Zurich - US 12/Rand Rd at Ela Rd (TIP ID 10-02-0007)

The sponsor requested to transfer sponsorship of the project to the Lake County DOT. Lake County DOT accepted sponsorship. Staff completed the change as an administrative modification.

Maywood – Train Station Facility (TIP ID 04-14-0002)

The sponsor notified staff that construction would be delayed to FFY 2016 due to coordination with railroads. Staff completed the change as an administrative modification.

ACTION REQUESTED: Information

7.0 FFY 2016-2020 CMAQ/FFY 2015-2016 TAP Program Development The call for projects is currently open and applications are due by close of business on Tuesday, March 3, 2015. ACTION REQUESTED: Information

1.0 Call to Order

Committee Chairman Patronsky called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

2.0 Agenda Changes and Announcements

Chairman Patronsky stated that agenda item 4.3 would be moved ahead of item 4.2.

3.0 Approval of Minutes – October 23, 2014

On a motion by President Rodeghier and a second by Mr. Pitstick, the minutes of the October 23, 2014 meeting were approved as presented.

4.0 **Program Monitoring**

4.1 **Programming Project Status Sheets**

Ms. Dobbs reported that the recurring reports on the programming status of active and deferred projects and the line item changes since the last meeting of the Project Selection Committee were included in the meeting packet.

4.2 Obligation Goal

Ms. Dobbs reported that the Programming Summary and Obligation Goals table shows that the region has already authorized \$63.8 million, which is 40% of the

FFY 2015 obligation goal. She noted that when accounting for the current year's program and past years' balances, the region is over-programmed by over \$48 million and if deferred projects that are not yet reinstated are added to that, the over-programmed amount is nearly \$75 million.

Ms. Dobbs said that, as reported at the committee's last meeting, the region started FFY 2014 with \$216 million programmed and ended the year having obligated about 64% of that due to changing status of line items throughout the year. She noted that the over-programming is not a concern at this time, except for the effect it has on fiscal constraint in the TIP. In response to a question from Mr. Pitstick, Ms. Dobbs explained that for the purpose of the obligation goal tracking, the committee looks at the overall program and current year programmed amounts include all past balances from incomplete projects, which total over \$27 million. She added that the TIP is a single year snapshot of programming, and that past years' balances remain in those past years and authorizations against them are accounted for in the end of year carryover amounts (typically in October). In response to a question from Mr. Privett, Ms. Dobbs explained that in reading the obligation goals table, the programmed amount of \$157 million, added to the already authorized amount of \$64 million, is what exceeds the goal of \$162 million.

4.3 Transit Quarterly Updates

Ms. Dixon reported that the memo summarizing transit agency and CDOT progress on expending funds obligated within FTA grants shows that approximately one third of the authorized funds have been expended to date. Only five of forty-seven projects were not underway as of September 30. She noted that staff will be working with sponsors to identify the final close-out of FTA grants. Per the recommendations of the recent federal certification review, staff will be working with sponsors, the FTA, IDOT, and FHWA to take back remaining balances for use on future projects. In response to questions from Mr. Snyder, Mr. Patronsky explained that in the past, CMAQ balances left in FTA grants were returned to Washington, not to the region and that only recently FTA's practice changed to return those funds to IDOT for CMAP's use. Mr. Pistick noted that CMAQ funds are flexed from FHWA to FTA as 5307 funds. Mr. Connelly added that in the past, when grants closed, unused funds were returned as part of carryover at the end of the year. Mr. Carmitchel and Mr. Donovan confirmed Mr. Patronsky's explanation and noted that the intent is for the take back to occur going forward; balances from grants closed in the past would not be sought.

5.0 Project Changes

Ms. Dobbs reported that ten projects have submitted scope and/or cost change requests for committee consideration and four administrative modifications were completed. She pointed out that at the top of the change memo there are two tables summarizing the impacts of the requested cost changes on the fiscal constraint of the TIP. The first table shows that approving all changes would result in a balance of negative \$12 million, which is not something that we can do. The second table summarizes the staff recommendation, which includes not approving one request, and tabling to the next committee meeting approval of two others targeting the April state letting. Tabling the two requests gives staff time to work with sponsors to reduce the programming commitments in FFY15 in the TIP. For example, she noted that the January letting includes some large projects, most

notably the DuPage Co. sponsored Elgin O'Hare related project for \$34 million. Based on the final engineer's estimate, only \$29.4 million was authorized by FHWA, a difference of \$4.6 million. If the bids come in close to the authorized amount, there is an opportunity to withdraw the remainder between the programmed amount and the low bid amount. Staff would apply the remainder in line with the procedure adopted in April 2012 leaving an extra 5% above the low bid programmed as a contingency, unless the County wanted to volunteer to release the entire difference.

5.1 McHenry County DOT – Randall Rd at Algonquin Rd Intersection Improvement and Signal Interconnect (TIP ID 11-03-0018)

Ms. Dobbs described the sponsor's request for a scope change from a Continuous Flow Intersection (CFI) to a conventional intersection. Mr. Dittrich added that the County spent local funds to re-evaluate the preferred alternative and determined that a conventional intersection design provides similar operational benefits to the original CFI design for similar costs and is preferred by the surrounding property owners and communities. He added that regardless of the design the same problem is being addressed at the same location. Mr. Snyder made a motion, seconded by Mr. Privett, to approve the requested scope change. The motion carried.

5.2 Skokie – Skokie Valley Trail from Oakton St. to Village Limits (TIP ID 02-12-0002)

Ms. Dobbs described the sponsor's request for a cost increase of \$67,000 federal (\$110,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2014. In response to a question from Mr. Snyder, she stated that the staff re-ranking does not include adjusting the costs of all projects to current year dollars. Mr. Privett added that he recalls there being a large pool of bicycle facilities projects during the 2012 cycle and requested the number of projects be added to future memos. Mr. Privett made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pitstick, to approve the requested cost increase. The motion carried.

5.3 Chicago Heights - Old Plank Road Trail Extension from Western to Euclid (TIP ID 07-01-0004)

Ms. Dobbs described the sponsor's request for a cost increase of \$439,000 federal (\$548,000 total) for construction/CE and in FFY 2015. President Rodeghier made a motion, seconded by Mr. Privett, to approve the requested cost increase. The motion carried.

5.4 Aurora - Station Blvd. Extension to IL 59 Commuter Parking Lot (TIP ID 09-14-0002)

Ms. Dobbs described the sponsor's request for a scope change and cost change of \$1,481,000 federal (\$1,635,000 total) for the construction phase, which is programmed in FFY 2015 and is targeting the April 2015 state letting. She stated that staff recommends tabling approval of the request to the next committee meeting due to fiscal constraint in the TIP at this time. Mr. Patronsky confirmed Mr. Connelly's statement that this project was the only commuter parking project selected in the 2014-18 programming cycle. Mr. Snyder made a motion, seconded by Mr. Rogers, to table consideration of the requested scope and cost changes. The motion carried.

5.5 IEPA – Norfolk Southern (TIP ID 13-10-0005)

Ms. Dobbs described the sponsor's request for a cost increase in the amount of \$3,400,000 federal (\$5,230,000 total) in FFY 2014. In response to a question from Mr. Pitstick, Mr. Patronsky explained that due to the timing of the last project selection cycle and the project agreement execution, the sponsor's application for funding for twelve additional locomotives was processed as a cost change. Mr. Smith from Norfolk Southern described the reasons for the cost change. He announced that the first locomotive will be delivered in January 2015, and reviewed the schedule for delivery of additional locomotives. In response to questions from Mr. Pitstick, Mr. Rogers and Mr. Smith clarified that the locomotives are Tier III line-haul locomotives that provide 40% higher reduction of PM_{2.5} emissions over Tier II switchers and will remain in the Chicago region for a minimum of ten years. In response to a question from Mr. Connelly, Mr. Patronsky confirmed that this project will help the region meet the MAP-21 requirement for 25% of CMAQ funds to be spent on direct reduction of PM_{2.5} emissions. Mr. Rogers made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pitstick, to approve the requested cost increase. The motion carried.

5.6 McHenry County – Miller Rd. (TIP ID 11-06-0032)

Ms. Dobbs described the sponsor's request for a cost increase in the amount of \$9,746,000 federal (\$10,888,000 total) for construction in FFY 2015. She stated that staff does not recommend approval of the request due to fiscal constraint and progress made shrinking the region's unobligated balance. Mr. Snyder stated that McHenry County supports the staff recommendation and noted that the project is moving forward on the January state letting using local funds. He thanked McHenry County for their willingness to help the region address the unobligated balance. Mr. Snyder made a motion, seconded by Mr. Pitstick to approve the staff recommendation. The motion carried.

5.7 CDOT – Union Station Transportation Center (TIP ID 01-09-0004)

Ms. Dobbs described the sponsor's request for a cost increase in the amount of \$3,400,000 federal (\$4,250,000 total) for ROW in FFY 2015. In response to a question from Mr. Pitstick, Mr. Privett stated that once the ROW is cleared, construction can begin. Mr. Schmidt made a motion, seconded by Mr. Rogers, to approve the requested cost increase. The motion carried.

5.8 IDOT – IL 59/Sutton Rd at Stearns Rd (TIP ID 03-12-0004)

Ms. Dobbs described the sponsor's request for a cost increase of \$1,392,000 federal (\$1,740,000 total) for ROW in FFY 2015 and \$1,040,000 federal (\$1,300,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2016 and scope change to dual left turn lanes on all legs and right turn lanes on the east, west, and north legs. Mr. Snyder made a motion, seconded by President Rodeghier, to approve the requested cost increase. The motion carried.

5.9 IDOT – IL 59 at W. Bartlett Rd (TIP ID 03-12-0002)

Ms. Dobbs described the sponsor's request for a cost increase of \$320,000 federal (\$400,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2015. She stated construction funds are

currently deferred and the project is targeting the April 2015 state letting and therefore staff recommends tabling approval of the request to the next committee meeting due to fiscal constraint in the TIP at this time. Mr. Pitstick made a motion, seconded by Mr. Privett, to table consideration of the request. The motion carried.

5.10 Metra – Installation of GenSets on Two Metra Switch Engines (TIP ID 13-10-0007)

Ms. Dobbs described the sponsor's request for a scope change to procure two Tier III repowered switch engine locomotives instead of retrofitting with GenSets due to the age of the existing locomotives and recommendations from several vendors. Mr. Snyder asked if, given the request approved earlier for the IEPA project, a cost increase in the future is likely. Mr. Weaver stated that if costs increase, Metra would not seek additional CMAQ funds. Mr. Rogers made a motion, seconded by Mr. Schmidt, to approve the requested scope change. The motion carried.

5.11 Administrative Modifications

Ms. Dobbs reported that staff completed four administrative modifications, as described in the CMAQ Project Change Requests memo.

6.0 FFY 2016-2020 CMAQ/FFY 2015-2016 TAP Application Booklet

Mr. Elam stated that a call for projects is planned for release in January 2015, with applications due in March. There will be one application for both CMAQ and TAP funds. He stated that members were sent the draft application booklet on December first, and were provided a review of changes including a definition of hardship for Phase 1 funding consideration, adjustments to the scoring scale for transit asset condition and the removal of points for the "design" criteria under transit supportive land use, the addition of access management as a criterion for highways and tightening of language related to events.

Mr. Pitstick thanked staff for working with members to refine the booklet and scoring procedures. He stated that the goal should be to not build in any geographic or mode bias in the program development. He stated that there has been a lot of work to understand the subtleties while not making the scoring too complex. He stated staff's adjustments regarding existing verses new facilities is good, but there may be potential issues related to bus stop locations which are grass verses those which have an adequate shelter. He stated the RTA is working with many communities on pedestrian friendly designs so that they are not penalized for being "not quite there" yet. He stated CTA measures on-time performance differently than Pace and Metra. Mr. Connelly stated the scoring is fine, despite the differences. Mr. Privett suggested that if the scoring turns out not to be okay, quartiles could be used. Mr. Pitstick stated he appreciates the flexibility to work with staff to fine tune scoring if needed.

In response to a question from Mr. Privett, Mr. Elam stated that the RTA asset database provides a standard source for condition ratings. Mr. Connelly added that although CTA data is not included in RTAMS, their condition ratings follow national standards and those can be provided. Mr. Privett stated staff and the committee should continue to evaluate the scoring procedures over time so that they remain meaningful and useful.

Mr. Privett expressed concern that application due dates fell on holidays observed by the city of Chicago. Mr. Rickert stated that mayors have been asking for a definition of

hardship and that the one provided is appreciated. He stated that the use of the CMP network may be beneficial to the state and counties, but may discourage municipalities from participating in the program.

Mr. Rickert stated the Kane/Kendall Council of Mayors held a meeting to review the draft application booklet with members; about half of the 36 member municipalities attended. They expressed concern about phase 2 engineering for signal interconnects not being eligible for CMAQ funding. Mr. Patronsky noted that this policy was included in the last call for projects. Mr. Rickert stated that municipalities were concerned about the policy then and now and many did not apply for projects in the last call.

Mr. Rickert noted a typo in the date of ROW certification on page 17 and expressed concern that 90 to 100% of projects won't be able to meet the milestones. Mr. Elam stated that staff used the outer limits of the estimated time to complete phases in the federal-aid flow chart and noted that with the current TAP program, there have not been too many issues with meeting milestones that would be cause for removal from the program. Mr. Rickert stated the flow chart hasn't been revised in a number of years and was likely more accurate 10-15 years ago. Mr. Privett added that the largest hold-up for completing projects is the ROW phase and suggested that if projects are held up, only construction funds should be withdrawn until ROW is cleared providing incremental actions rather than wholesale removal from the program.

In response to a question from Mr. Snyder, Mr. Elam stated that completed phase 1 engineering is a requirement for receiving either CMAQ or TAP funding. Mr. Snyder suggested adopting management policies for TAP that are similar to CMAQ. Mr. Elam stated that because it is a smaller program, TAP is managed through quarterly updates to the Transportation Committee. He noted that staff is trying to get TAP on the same cycle with CMAQ but noted that, with the uncertainty of continuation of this new program, staff is hesitant to program beyond two years and does not want to fill a program just to fill it. Mr. Privett noted one benefit of a three year program is that phase 2 engineering can be programmed in year 1, with construction in year 3.

Mr. Snyder noted that even the counties have some concerns about the use of the CMP network rather than ADT values and the hope is that projects not on the CMP will score well in other categories. He stated that an evaluation of how the scoring works should be completed.

Mr. Snyder noted a discrepancy between the schedule in the draft application book and the meeting calendar later on the agenda. Mr. Elam stated that the application booklet will be changed to correspond with the meeting calendar.

Mr. Rickert stated that the inclusion of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Task Force in the TAP project selection process is good and that the removal of cost increases from the TAP program will improve transparency.

In response to questions from Mr. Privett and Mr. Snyder, Mr. Ferguson noted that in the past a meeting was held to release the rankings, with no action taken and that the proposed schedule excludes this extra meeting. The rankings will be ready for the focus groups in May, prior to the proposed June meeting of the PSC. Mr. Patronsky noted that

the Transportation Committee is meeting in early July. In response to a question from Mr. Privett, Mr. Ferguson stated that public comment would open after the July meeting of the Transportation Committee. Mr. Privett stated that this timing means that in June the PSC would be expected to make a recommendation to the Transportation Committee. Mr. Rogers stated that June would then be the time for sponsors to present projects to the committee. Mr. Ferguson stated that staff discourages sponsor presentations and that those could be made during the public comment period. Mr. Snyder asked for confirmation that rankings will be available in May, the focus groups will make recommendations for PSC consideration in June, the PSC will be asked to make a recommendation at the June meeting for Transportation Committee consideration in July, and that there will be time for adjustments to the proposed program during public comment. Mr. Ferguson confirmed.

7.0 2015 CMAQ Meeting Schedule

Mr. Patronsky stated that the proposed 2015 meeting schedule was included in the agenda. The schedule also included, for information, the due dates for change requests for each proposed meeting. Mr. Schmidt asked if it is okay to have fewer meetings relative to both the state letting schedule and application rankings. Mr. Snyder stated that the committee can schedule additional meetings at any time if needed. Ms. Dobbs responded that based on the state letting schedule, changes affecting projects targeting both the June and July 2015 lettings will be considered at the March committee meeting. All other meetings correspond to a single state letting. The full Transportation Meetings and Deadlines calendar will include the committee meetings, due dates and lettings, along with TIP change deadlines and other committee meetings. Mr. Privett noted that the proposed September meeting is just prior to the Labor Day holiday.

Ms. Berry noted that recently there have been many project change requests received at the last minute or after the published deadline. She stated that the deadlines are hard and are set to allow staff the time to complete the evaluations and follow-up with sponsors. Mr. Snyder made a motion, seconded by Mr. Rogers, to approve the 2015 Project Selection Committee meeting schedule. The motion carried.

8.0 MAP-21

Mr. Donovan stated that the FFY 15 appropriation bill includes \$500 million for TIGER 7, which is \$100 million less than FFY 14. He stated that nationally, highway funding totals are identical; however Illinois will receive slightly less funding in FFY 15. The HSIP program includes performance measures for FFY 15. He stated there are no rescissions or across the board cuts and the ½ percentage cut proposed in September was eliminated. In response to a question from Mr. Weaver, he stated that he has not received any indication from his counterparts at FTA on when apportionments will be available.

9.0 Other Business

Mr. Patronsky noted that the US EPA announced a proposal to update the air quality standard for ground-level ozone from the current 75 ppb to 65-70 ppb. Designations based on the proposed standard would be issued in December of 2017, based on 2014-2016 data. In response to a question from Mr. Snyder, Mr. Patronsky stated that by law the standards are based on health impacts, not economic impacts and that CMAP does not have the scientific expertise to warrant commenting on the proposal. Mr. Donovan added

that there are some proposed bills that would force the consideration of economic impacts, in addition to health impacts.

10.0 Public Comment

None.

11.0 Next Meeting

The committee's next meeting is scheduled for February 19, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.

12.0 Adjournment

On a motion by Mr. Rogers, and a second by Mr. Schmidt, the meeting adjourned at 3:30 p.m.

Staff conducted the Quarterly Transit Project Expenditure Update. This effort is intended to track transit project expenditures after each project has been obligated. Of the 44 transit projects reported on this quarter, 12 are complete, but not closed out. 5 projects have not expended any CMAQ funds yet. The table below summarizes the agencies' responses and provides federal dollars expended, unexpended balances, and the percent of obligated CMAQ funds expended on each agency's projects (excluding completed projects) to show the degree to which active projects are yet to be undertaken.

Re: CMAQ Project Change Requests for consideration on December 18th

Thirteen projects have submitted scope, schedule, and/or cost change requests for committee consideration. Five administrative modifications were completed. The sponsors' requests are attached; re-ranking analyses are available upon request.

A summary of the impacts of the requested cost changes on the fiscal constraint of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is shown below.

For Committee Consideration:

Aurora – Station Blvd Ext. to IL 59 Commuter Parking Lot (TIP ID 09-14-0002)

This project was originally approved for \$100,000 federal (\$125,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2014 and \$1,506,000 federal (\$1,883,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2015 for a project total of \$1,606,000 federal (\$2,008,000 total).

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase and a scope change. The requested cost increase is for construction/CE in the amount of \$1,186,000 federal (\$1,635,000 total). The scope change is the result of final engineering design and discussions between BNSF, Metra, Pace and City of Aurora staff. The revised plan provides for a variety of improvements to enhance mobility and traffic circulation and will result in an additional 420 parking spaces, which is an increase of 13 parking spaces from the initial application. If the cost increase is granted the total project cost

would increase to \$2,792,000 federal (\$3,643,000 total). The project is targeting the April 2015 state letting.

A re-ranking was completed. Since this was the only commuter parking project selected in the FFY 14-18 program the project ranking did not change. The cost per Kg VOC eliminated increased from \$116 to \$200.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the scope change and cost increase of \$1,186,000 federal (\$1,635,000 total) for construction/CE for a total project cost of \$2,792,000 federal (\$3,643,000 total) for Aurora – Station Blvd Ext. to IL 59 Commuter Parking Lot (TIP ID 09-14-0002).

IDOT – IL 59 at W. Bartlett Rd (TIP ID 03-12-0002)

This project was originally approved for \$0 federal (\$90,000 total) for phase 1 and 2 engineering in FFY 2012, \$96,000 federal (\$120,000 total) for ROW in FFY 2012, and \$480,000 federal (\$600,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2013 for a project total of \$576,000 federal (\$810,000 total). Construction funds are currently deferred.

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$320,000 federal (\$400,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2015 as a result of the availability of 75% design cost estimate based on detailed quantity calculations and current bid tab pricing. If the cost increase is granted the total project cost would increase to \$896,000 federal (\$1,210,000 total). The project is targeting the April 2015 state letting.

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking changing from 8th to 19th among all 2012-2016 Intersection Improvement proposals. The ranking among funded projects changed from 2nd to 10th. 27 funded projects remain ranked lower than 10th.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the cost increase of \$320,000 federal (\$400,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2015 and the reinstatement of deferred funds for IDOT – IL 59 at W. Bartlett Rd (TIP ID 03-12-0002).

CDOT – State/Lake Station (Loop Elevated) (TIP ID 01-02-0030)

This project was originally approved for \$480,000 federal (\$600,000 total) for phase 1 engineering in FFY 2002, \$4,000,000 federal (\$5,000,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2017.

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to move \$4,000,000 federal (\$5,000,000 total) for phase 2 engineering currently programmed in FFY 2017 to FFY 2015. Since there was no cost change a re-ranking of the project was not done.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends reprogramming \$2,000,000 federal (\$2,500,000 total) in both FFY 2015 and FFY 2016 for phase 2 engineering from FFY 2017 to FFY 2015 for CDOT – State/Lake Station (Loop Elevated) (TIP ID 01-02-0030) if IDOT, FHWA, FTA and the sponsor agree that the phase can proceed to be federally authorized in FFY 2015 with funds programmed in both years.

Lake County – Washington St. Bike Path (sidepath) (TIP ID 10-10-0002)

This project was originally approved for \$96,000 federal (\$194,595 total) for phase 1 engineering in FFY 2011, \$40,000 federal (\$50,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2012, and \$624,480 federal (\$737,160 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2013 for a project total of \$760,480 federal (\$1,146,154 total). In 2012 \$59,228 and \$107,373 in federal funds were transferred from construction to phase 1 and phase 2 engineering respectively. In February 2014 a cost increase was approved for \$142,000 federal (\$164,400 total) for construction.

The sponsor is requesting to transfer \$50,182 federal (\$62,728 total) from phase 1 engineering and \$14,112 federal (\$17,640 total) from phase 2 engineering back to construction/CE in and a cost increase of \$17,000 federal (\$19,750 total) for construction in FFY 2014. The increase being sought is the result of the low bid exceeding the pre-letting estimate. This project has already been bid twice. If the cost increase is granted the total project cost would increase to \$919,000 federal (\$1,166,250 total).

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking unchanged at 8th among 2010 Bicycle Facility projects.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the requested transfer of \$50,182 federal (\$62,728 total) from phase I engineering and \$14,112 federal (\$17,640 total) from phase 2 engineering to construction/CE and cost increase of \$17,000 federal (\$19,750 total) in FFY 2014 for a total project cost of \$919,000 federal (\$1,166,250 total) for Lake County – Washington St. Bike Path (sidepath) (TIP ID 10-10-0002).

Lake County DOT – US 12/Rand Road at Ela Road (TIP ID 10-02-0007)

This project was originally approved for \$42,617 federal (\$53,271 total) for phase 1 engineering in FFY 2002, \$35,000 federal (\$43,750 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2003, and \$450,783 federal (\$564,021 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2005 for a project total of \$528,400 federal (\$661,042 total). A cost increase was approved in July 2005 for \$148,000 federal (\$185,000 total) for construction and in April 2013 for \$51,000 federal (\$63,750 total) for phase 2 engineering. The currently approved total project cost is \$727,400 federal (\$910,300 total).

Sponsorship of the project was transferred from Lake Zurich to the Lake County DOT on February 2, 2015 via an administrative modification. Lake County is requesting a cost increase of \$95,000 federal (\$119,000 total) for construction in FFY 2015 due to accommodating Complete Streets in the pre-final plans. The project is targeting the April 24, 2015 letting. If the cost increase is granted the total project cost would increase to \$822,600 federal (\$1,029,300 total).

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking remaining unchanged at 5th among 2005 intersection improvements.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Approval of the cost increase of \$95,000 federal (\$119,000 total) in FY 2015 for a total project cost of \$822,600 federal (\$1,029,300 total) for Lake County DOT – US 12/Rand Road at Ela Road (TIP ID 10-02-0007).

IDOT – I-55 Bus on Shoulder Demonstration Project (TIP ID 01-09-0034)

The project was originally programmed in 2006 for \$1,200,000 federal (\$1,500,000 total) for implementation. Cost increases were approved in October 2012 for \$36,376 total (\$29,101 federal) and in June 2013 for \$245,411 federal (\$306,764 total) bringing the total programmed amount to \$1,474,512 federal (\$1,843,140 total).

Six separate authorizations have occurred for this project from FFY 2011 through FFY 2013. Five of the six occurred at a 90/10 federal share. Although the total cost of these previously authorized phases was less than programmed, the sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$128,000 federal to address the over-authorization of federal funds. Additionally the sponsor is seeking a cost increase in the amount of \$480,000 federal (\$600,000 total) in FFY 2013 to provide an additional year of shoulder sweeping. The first year of shoulder sweeping was funded using State funds only. The combined cost increases equal \$508,000 federal (\$560,000 total).

If the cost increases are granted the total project cost would be \$1,982,512 federal \$(2,403,140 total). This project was funded as a demonstration project; as such emissions benefits were not evaluated.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Approval of the requested cost increase in the amount of \$508,000 federal (\$600,000 total) in FFY 2013 for total project cost of \$1,982,512 federal \$(2,403,140 total) for IDOT – I-55 Bus on Shoulder Demonstration Project (TIP ID 01-09-0034).

Homer Glen – Homer Glen community Trail – South Extension (TIP ID 12-12-0002)

This project was originally approved for \$31,000 federal (\$39,000 total) for phase 1 engineering in FFY 2012, \$31,000 federal (\$39,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2013, and \$360,000 federal (\$450,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2014 for a project total of \$422,000 federal (\$528,000 total).

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$48,000 federal (\$60,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2015 in order to purchase unanticipated Wetland Bank credits. Pre-final plans are under review at IDOT and the project is targeting the June 12, 2015 state letting. If the cost increase is granted the total project cost would increase to \$470,000 federal (\$588,000 total).

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking changing from 10th to 12th among all 2012-2016 Bicycle Facilities proposals. The ranking among funded projects was unchanged at 9th.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Approval of the cost increase in the amount \$48,000 federal (\$60,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2015 for a project total cost of \$470,000 federal (\$588,000 total) for Homer Glen – Homer Glen community Trail – South Extension (TIP ID 12-12-0002).

Kane County - Kirk Road at Douglas Road (TIP ID 09-08-0002)

This project was originally approved for \$56,000 federal (\$70,000 total) for phase 1 engineering in FFY 2008, \$80,000 federal (\$100,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2009, \$160,000 federal CMAQ (\$200,000 total) for Right of Way acquisition (ROW) in FFY 2012, and \$720,000 federal (\$900,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2014 for a project total of \$1,016,000 federal (\$1,270,000 total).

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$151,590 federal (\$172,587 total) for construction in FFY2014 due to bids being higher than the engineer's estimate. If the cost increase is granted the total project cost would increase to \$1,167,590 federal (\$1,459,488 total).

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking changing from 7th to 8th among 2008 Intersection Improvement projects.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Approval of the cost increase in the amount of \$151,590 federal (\$172,587 total) for construction in FFY2014 for a project total of \$1,167,590 federal (\$1,459,488 total) for Kane County – Kirk Road at Douglas Road (TIP ID 09-08-0002).

DuPage County DOT – 55th St/CH 35 from Dunham Rd to Clarendon Hills Rd and 55th St at Main St (TIP ID 08-12-0004)

This project was originally programmed as two separate projects which were combined under this TIP ID in 2012. The combined project has a programed amount of \$236,000 federal (\$295,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in 2015, \$148,000 federal (\$185,000 total) for Right of Way acquisition (ROW) in FFY 2015, and \$1,784,000 federal (\$2,230,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2016 for a project total of \$2,168,000 federal (\$2,950,000 total).

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$130,000 federal (\$163,000 total) for Phase 2 Engineering in FFY 2015, \$297,000 federal (\$371,000 total) for ROW in FFY 15 and \$1,306,000 federal (\$1,632,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2016 for a total cost increase of \$1,733,000 federal (\$2,166,000 total). The requested cost increase is based on final phase 1 engineering cost estimates. This project also includes STP-L funded resurfacing and intersection improvements. If the cost increase is granted the total project cost would increase to \$3,901,000 federal (\$5,116,000 total). A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking changing from 74th to 79th among all 2012-2016 Intersection Improvement proposals. The ranking among funded projects was unchanged at 35th.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Approval of the cost increase in the amount \$130,000 federal (\$163,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2015, \$297,000 federal (\$371,000 total) for ROW in FFY 15 and \$1,306,000 federal (\$1,632,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2016 for a project total of \$3,901,000 federal (\$5,116,000 total) for DuPage County DOT – 55th St/CH 35 from Dunham Rd to Clarendon Hills Rd and 55th St at Main St (TIP ID 08-12-0004).

DuPage County DOT - Fabyan Parkway/Washington St., @ IL Route 83 (Roosevelt Road) (TIP ID 08-12-0006)

This project was originally approved for \$200,000 federal (\$250,000 total) for ROW in FFY 2012, \$525,000 federal (\$750,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2012, and \$5,600,000 federal (\$8,000,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2014 for a project total of \$6,325,000 federal (\$9,000,000 total). This project has received three prior cost increases totaling \$3,609,000 federal (\$3,878,000 total) and is currently programmed for \$549,000 federal (\$686,000 total) for ROW in FFY 2013, \$1,137,000 federal (\$1,421,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2013, and \$8,302,000 federal (\$10,377,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2015 for a project total of \$9,934,000 federal (\$12,878,000 total).

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$54,000 federal (\$67,000 total) for construction in FFY 2015. The project was let on January 30, 2015 and the low bid exceeded the engineer's estimate. If the cost increase is granted the total project cost would increase to \$9,988,000 federal (\$12,945,000 total).

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking unchanged at 72nd among all 2012-2016 Intersection Improvement proposals. The ranking among funded projects was also unchanged at 34th.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Approval of the requested cost increase of \$54,000 federal CMAQ (\$67,000 total) for construction in FFY 2015 for a project total of \$9,988,000 federal (\$12,945,000 total) for DuPage County DOT - Fabyan Parkway/Washington St., @ IL Route 83 (Roosevelt Road) (TIP ID 08-12-0006).

Lincolnwood - Touhy Av Overpass (Skokie Valley Bike Trail) (TIP ID 02-12-0003)

This project was originally approved for \$88,000 federal (\$110,000 total) for phase 1 engineering in FFY 2012, \$88,000 federal (\$110,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2014, and \$1,256,000 federal (\$1,570,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2016, for a project total of \$1,432,000 federal (\$1,790,000 total). A cost increase was approved in February 2013 for \$53,520 federal (\$66,900 total) for construction/CE. The currently approved total project cost is \$1,485,520 federal (\$1,856,900 total).

The sponsor is requesting a cost increase of \$17,000 federal (\$22,000 total) for phase 1 engineering, which was authorized in FFY 2014, \$143,000 federal (\$179,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2015 and \$1,923,000 federal (\$2,404,000 total) for construction in FFY 2016 based on phase 1 engineering estimates. Funds for phase 2 engineering and construction are currently deferred. Reinstatement of phase 2 engineering funds will be considered when phase 1 design approval has been granted and the locally executed agreements for phase 2 are forwarded to IDOT Central Office for execution. If the cost increase is granted the total project cost would increase to \$3,569,000 federal (\$4,462,000 total).

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking changing from 18th to 38th among all 2012-2016 Bicycle Facilities proposals. The ranking among funded projects changed from 11th to 17th. Seven funded projects remain ranked lower than 17th.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Approval of the cost increase of \$17,000 federal (\$22,000 total) for phase 1 engineering, which was authorized in FFY 2014, \$143,000 federal (\$179,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2015 and \$1,923,000 federal (\$2,404,000 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2016 for a project total of to \$3,569,000 federal (\$4,462,000 total) for Lincolnwood – Touhy Ave Overpass (Skokie Valley Bike Trail) (TIP ID 02-12-0003).

Park Forest - Bicycle Lanes and Way-Finding Signs on Lakewood Blvd, Indianwood Blvd, Orchard Dr and Blackhawk Dr (TIP ID 07-14-0009)

This project was originally approved for \$8,586 federal (\$10,733 total) for phase 2 engineering in 2014, \$94,454 federal (\$118,067 total) for construction/CE in 2014 and \$5,000 federal (\$10,000 total) for Implementation (Bike Maps) in 2014 for a project total of \$108,040 federal (\$138,800 total). The sponsor used 100% local funds for phase 2 engineering, which is currently in progress.

The sponsor is requesting a scope change to exclude Indianwood Blvd and Orchard Dr. from the project, and add Westwood Dr., Wildwood Dr. and Shabbona Dr. to the project. The requested changes result in a cost increase of \$8,586 federal (\$10,733 total) for construction in FFY 2015. If the cost increase is granted the total project cost would increase to \$108,040 federal (\$138,800 total). The project is targeting the September 2015 state letting. If the cost increase is granted the total project (\$149,533 total).

A re-ranking was completed with the project ranking changing from 4th to 5th among all 2014-2018 Bicycle Facilities proposals. The ranking among funded projects changed from 2nd to 3rd. Eight funded projects remain ranked lower than 3rd.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the scope change to exclude Indianwood Blvd and Orchard Dr. from the project, and add Westwood Dr., Wildwood Dr. and Shabbona Dr. and cost increase of \$8,586 federal (\$10,733 total) for construction in FFY 2015 for Park Forest - Bicycle Lanes and Way-Finding Signs on Lakewood Blvd, Indianwood Blvd, Orchard Dr and Blackhawk Dr (TIP ID 07-14-0009).

Kane County DOT - Fabyan Parkway at Kaneville Rd. (TIP ID 09-12-0006)

This project was originally approved for \$88,000 federal (\$110,000 total) for phase 1 engineering in FFY 2013, \$112,000 federal (\$140,000 total) for phase 2 engineering in FFY 2014, and \$1,083,100 federal (\$1,353,800 total) for construction/CE in FFY 2016 for a project total of \$1,283,100 federal (\$1,611,800 total).

The sponsor is requesting a schedule change to move construction funds currently programmed in FFY 2016 into FFY 2015. The project is targeting the June 12, 2015 state letting.

Recommendation to the CMAQ Project Selection Committee:

Staff recommends approval of the schedule change to move \$1,083,100 federal construction funds currently programmed in FFY 2016 into FFY 2015 for Kane County DOT – Fabyan Parkway at Kaneville Rd. (TIP ID 09-12-0006).

Administrative Modifications

Staff completed the following administrative modifications:

Romeoville – 135th Street and New Ave Metra Parking and Platforms (SW Quadrant) (TIP ID 12-10-0001)

The sponsor requested reinstatement of \$440,000 federal CMAQ funding for phase 2 engineering. Phase 1 design approval was granted on September 29, 2014 and readiness was demonstrated for phase 2. Staff completed the reinstatement as an administrative modification.

FPD of Will County - DuPage River Trail - Segment 5 (TIP ID 12-12-0001)

The sponsor requested reinstatement of \$68,000 federal CMAQ funding for phase 2 engineering. Phase 1 design approval was granted on December 11, 2014 and readiness was demonstrated for phase 2. Staff completed the reinstatement as an administrative modification.

Kane County DOT – Huntley Road at Galligan Road (TIP ID 09-09-0010)

The sponsor requested a schedule change for the construction phase from FFY 2015 to FFY2016 due to delays with ROW acquisition. The project is currently deferred. However, \$1,058,840 federal for construction was reinstated in October 2013 based on pre-final plans having been submitted in May of 2013. Construction is currently targeting the January 2016 state letting. Staff completed the schedule change as an administrative modification.

Lake Zurich - US 12/Rand Rd at Ela Rd (TIP ID 10-02-0007)

The sponsor requested to transfer sponsorship of the project to the Lake County DOT. Lake County DOT accepted sponsorship. Staff completed the change as an administrative modification.

Maywood – Train Station Facility (TIP ID 04-14-0002)

The sponsor notified staff that construction would be delayed to FFY 2016 due to coordination with railroads. Staff completed the change as an administrative modification.

Revised Project Scope

As the City moved into final engineering design phase and had discussions with BNSF, Metra, Pace and City Staff, the original concept design submitted with the City's grant application has changed, which resulted in a change in project scope and cost. The revised plan provides for a variety of improvements to enhance mobility and traffic circulation and will: 1. Address and incorporate BNSF, Metra and Pace comments, 2. Provide safer pedestrian walkway with improve flow of traffic from one mode of transit to another, 3. Reduce pedestrian/auto/bus conflict with the relocation of Pace staging area and provide higher level of service for buses departing from the parking lot, 4. Add 420 parking spaces which increased the total additional by 13 as compared to the initial application (407 additional parking spaces; existing 2,248, proposed 2,668)

Below is a brief summary of our proposed scope changes. Please also reference the attach exhibit 1 which is the original concept plan provided in the initial application and exhibit 2, which is the current design.

- 1. The driveway aisles have been changed to run north to south to provide safer pedestrian route. Instead of angled parking, the parking is now perpendicular (90) to the drive aisle.
- 2. A new sidewalk was added to connect the existing sidewalk to existing west side of the platform. This will allow for better pedestrian access as well as safer condition during snow removal operations on the platform.
- 3. Existing Pace staging/drop off area will be relocated to the east parking lot. At the current drop off area, pedestrian movements are through the drop off area, which is a safety concern. In addition, the Pace buses are currently experiencing congestion during peak hour demands. A traffic control device will be installed at the Pace access drive and will be interconnected to the Traffic Signal at Station Blvd and Meridian Lakes Drive to provide Pace and the City Trolley priority. This will allow much faster and easier departures then existing conditions and we would hope this will result in increased Pace ridership. The proposed drop off platform can accommodate 8 buses and currently there are 5 Pace bus routes.
- 4. Additional driveways have been added from the parking lot to Meridian Lakes Dr. to increase exiting capacity during peak hours. This included a full access main driveway centered on the western half of the parking lot and aligned with an existing full access.
- 5. Due to the fact that some of the parking lot lights are over 20 years old and the isle orientation is being rotated, the existing parking lot lighting will be replaced. Relocating and reusing the existing lights is not recommended because of their condition, warranty and safety concerns. The City is planning to use LED fixtures.

The change in scope and design resulted in changes in construction costs. The City is respectfully requesting a cost increase in CMAQ funds and a Change is Cost Request Form is also being submitted for consideration.
