## Planning agency to give Fox River Corridor Plan update during Green Drinks meeting

[CRYSTAL LAKE](#) – An associate planner for the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning will attend an upcoming Green Drinks McHenry County meeting to discuss the [Fox River Corridor Plan](#).

The meeting will be from 5 to 7 p.m. Wednesday at Duke's Alehouse and Kitchen, 110 N. Main St., Crystal Lake, according to the website for Green Drinks, a group of the [Environmental Defenders of McHenry County](#).

Associate Planner for CMAP Brian Daly said the agency intends to provide information and an update on the Fox River Corridor Plan – a collaborative effort between [Algonquin](#) and [Carpentersville](#) through the agency's Local Technical Assistance Program.

The goal is to improve water quality, increase access to the river and better use it to enhance the two downtown areas.

“We'll be talking about the background of the plan, what we've done so far, where the process stands now, and give possible direction for moving forward,” Daly said.
