







































GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

- Corridor is host to a large and active collection of civic groups
- Existing multijurisdictional groups, but none have same boundaries
- River inspires loyalty and civic activity

Recommendations: Placemaking and Economic Development

- Pursue downtown economic development
- Draw people to the Fox River through programming and open space
- Market Fox River as paddling
- Develop signage and wayfinding

Recommendations: Land Use Algonquin Mix of residential types and densities to support retail Market Village's downtown development efforts to real estate community Expand use of "Old Town" zoning designation Improve public riverfront access and open space Encourage residential infill Revise zoning code

Recommendations: Transportation and Circulation - Connect bicycle trails to regional network - Advocate for corridor needs in Longmeadow Parkway process - Invest in walkability
