





- Cluster identification laid a foundation for regional economy work

New Cluster Research

- □ Measurable industry linkages
- Co-location, labor pooling, input-output linkages.
- Categorization of cluster types

Industry Cluster Types

Local

- Found in all regions
- Serve the local market
- Cluster size dependent on local population
- Moderate average wage

Traded

- Found in **few** regions
- Serve the global market
- Cluster size not related to population
- High average wage



Local Cluster Types

Business to Consumer

- Serves local consumers
- Community level
- Necessary goods and services
- Low average wage

Business to Business

- Serves local businesses
- Regional level
- Foundation for traded clusters
- Moderate average wage
