



DEMONSTRATION PHASE SUCCESSFUL

RTA Interagency Signage Program: Challenges

- The RTA does not own or control interagency locations
- Property ownership fragmented
- Consensus/approval by partners required
- Permission/Permits/Rights-of-Access

 - Service Boards, (CTA, Metra and Pace)
 Class I Railroads, (BNSF, Union Pacific, Canadian National) and Amtrak
 City of Chicago and Chicago Park District (Downtown Locations)
 Host municipalities (region-wide locations)
- New role for RTA
