# North Lawndale Neighborhood Plan **Project History**

- Application submitted to CMAP for Local Technical Assistance
  - North Lawndale Community Coordinating Council (NLCCC)
- Scope of Work & Community Outreach Strategy developed with feedback from:
  - NLCCC Executive Committee
  - City of Chicago Department of Planning & Development
  - Alderman Scott
  - Implementation Partners (e.g. LISC, CTA, CDOT, etc.)
- MOU signed on February 17, 2016





# Local Technical Assistance (LTA) Program

- Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) is the official regional planning organization for the 7county northeastern Illinois region.
- LTA program provides assistance to communities across the Chicago metropolitan region to undertake planning projects that advance the principles of the GO TO 2040 comprehensive regional plan.
- Since the initiation of the LTA program in 2011, CMAP has completed over 120 local planning projects, with over 40 more currently underway.






# Local Technical Assistance (LTA) Program

- Major project types:
  - Comprehensive plans
  - Revisions to zoning or other ordinances
  - Small-area plans
  - Topic-specific projects water, housing, parking...





# LTA Program Land Use Planning

- Process to create a guide for current and desired future use, activity, or development of land in a community.
- General distribution of land
- Location of uses
- Characteristics of uses
- Current and future land use for a 10-15 year period

- Industrial
- Recreational

# **Zoning ≠ Land Use Planning**

- Plans inform and support development regulations (zoning).
- Plans characterize types of desired activities and uses.

Plans establish
 guidelines for
 development to achieve

 goals.

- Zoning is a tool for implementing a Land Use Plan.
- Zoning explicitly defines type and intensity of uses permitted on a given parcel.
- Zoning specifies required amount and design of parking, landscaping, and other site enhancements.

## Steps to Create a Land Use Plan

- Identify Issues
- Collect & Analyze Information
- Meet with the Community
- Map Current & Planned Projects
- Define Goals & Identify Focus Areas and Projects
- Develop Policies
- Prepare & Adopt Plan Document





### How?

- Engage local organizations and residents in conversations about the future of their neighborhood.
- Build on existing neighborhood assets as catalysts for broader investment and redevelopment.
- Create land use plan and policies that respond to the needs and desires of the community as well as economic, demographic, and other realities.




