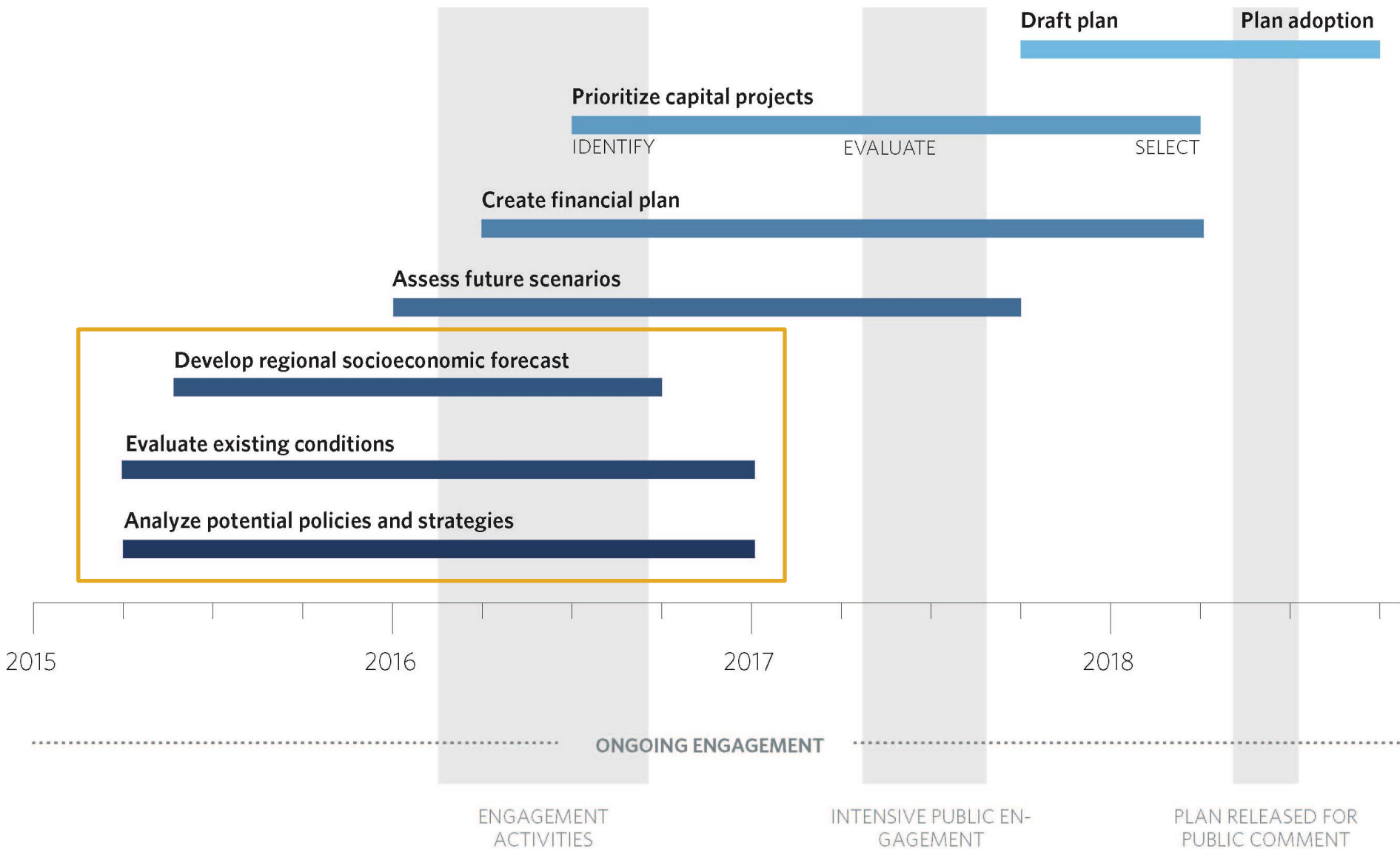

- Explore limited new policy areas supportive of CMAP's land use and transportation responsibilities
- Strive for greater specificity in the plan's policies:
  - Through refinement of existing policies
  - Through development of a place-based approach that provides more guidance for implementers

## **Resource Groups\***

- Denoted with an asterisk (\*)
- Created for cross-committee topics and for subject areas new to CMAP
- Include current CMAP committee members as well as key stakeholders and topic area experts
- Inform specific strategy papers

Ongoing interviews, data requests, and communication with key stakeholders as needed

Exploration of refinements to GO TO 2040 policies or new policy areas:

- Climate resilience\*
- Green infrastructure co-benefits
- Housing supply and affordability
- Inclusive growth\*
- Lands in transition\*
- Place-based approach
- Reinvestment and infill strategies\*
- Tax policies and land use trends
- Transportation system funding concepts
- Emphasis areas for transportation: asset management\*, highway operations, transit modernization\*
- *FY 17: possible new topics include transportation technology, stormwater, community capacity, economic resilience, energy, public health, and others*
