3.1 Regional Greenways and Trails Plan Update

CMAP staff (Brian Daly) will present the status and timeline of the draft Regional Greenways and Trails Plan update, including the draft plan map. 3.2 Village of South Holland and Cook County Department of Transportation & Highways – Road Diets and Cook County's Long Range Transportation Plan

Staff from the Village of South Holland, Cook County DOTH, and consulting engineers from Robinson Engineering will present on recent roadway improvement projects aimed at increasing safety and connectivity and on the County's recently adopted Long Range Transportation Plan ("Connecting Cook County"). Robinson engineer, James Hus's presentation will focus on road dieting to reallocate roadway ROW to create safer streets, higher quality pedestrian and bicycle accommodations, and to meet the community needs.
