**Re:** Near Term External Implementation of ON TO 2050

On June 15th, a draft of ON TO 2050 will be released for public comment. Before the final plan is adopted on October 10, there is an opportunity to compile these comments, summarize them, and make revisions. In preparation for a seamless transition from plan development to implementation and based on input from the CMAP Board, committees, and other stakeholders, staff have prioritized a series of near term implementation projects, with a focus on those that require support or participation from external stakeholders. At this time, staff are working to scope projects, form needed partnerships, or raise funds. In some cases, staff have already begun to execute project tasks.

The list below identifies implementation projects that require external partnerships. All of these projects are still in the formative stages. Staff is seeking input from the CMAP Board and committees at this time and will continue to do so at regular intervals in the future. It is anticipated that many of these projects will ultimately be reflected in the FY 2020 agency work plan. Processes already included in the FY 2019 work plan or already underway, such as development of programming criteria for the CMAQ program, are not included on this list.
