5.0 PM2.5 SIP Submission

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) will be holding a public hearing at 11 AM on July 14, 2010 at the James R. Thompson Center in Chicago to take comments on the proposed Maintenance Plan and associated draft motor vehicle emissions budgets related to the 1997 annual PM2.5 National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS). The Illinois EPA proposes to submit this to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) as a SIP revision to meet the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act (CAA). The U.S. EPA has made a determination that the Chicago area has attained the 1997 fine particle standard based on monitoring data from 2007 through 2009. The draft Maintenance Plan contains the State's plan for maintaining the annual fine particulate NAAQS for at least 10 years after U.S. EPA redesignates the area to attainment. The SIP revisions will also establish new transportation conformity motor vehicle emissions budgets for the years 2008 and 2025 for the nonattainment area. The Illinois EPA will discuss the development of the Maintenance Plan and the associated motor vehicle emissions budgets.
