- Understanding agriculture's relationship to the region's economy and food system security is important when making land use decisions.
- Developing an understanding of the geographic relationship between food access, demographics, transportation, and community vulnerability is important for local planners.



Local Food Snapshot – Context and Progress

GO TO 2040

Goals:

- Promote sustainable local food
 - Facilitate local food production
 - Increase access to healthy food
 - Raise understanding and awareness of nutrition and food policy

Indicators:

- Acreage of land in the region being used to harvest food for human consumption
- Value/percentage value of agricultural products sold directly to individuals for human consumption in the region
- Percentage of population living in food deserts



Number of Farms


Number of Farmland Acres






Acreage of Regional Farmland Used to Harvest Food for Direct Human Consumption


Percentage of Regional Farmland Used to Harvest Food for Direct Human Consumption






