# **Key Drivers**

- Baby boomers, millennials, and the generations that follow them increasingly prefer to live in walkable, caroptional places.
- · Technology makes living a car-free lifestyle easier

## **Impacts**

- Increased mixed use, walkable development throughout the region
- Jobs in **knowledge**, **service**, **and retail** locate near transit and in population centers
- More people use shared modes, active transportation, and transit
- High-cost walkable communities become increasingly segregated while auto-oriented areas diversify
- Reduced greenhouse gas emissions and greenfield development
- Residents of walkable communities have a higher quality of life

# **Disproportionately Impacted Communities**

- · Lower income populations
- Workers in manufacturing, warehousing industries
- Auto-oriented suburban communities without downtowns
- · Historically disinvested communities

# **Selected Strategies**

- Focus transportation investments on enhancing transit service, managing arterial congestion and safety, and efficiently moving freight
- Improve connections between shared and active modes of transportation
- Explore and develop new funding mechanisms for transportation infrastructure
