On **Thursday, June 22, 2017,** the City of Aurora, in partnership with the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP), will host a public open house for its draft Downtown Master Plan in Paramount Theater's Meyer Ballroom from **4:00 to 7:00 p.m.** The Downtown Master Plan has been developed to update, complement, and enhance the 2005 Seize the Future Master Plan to strengthen downtown Aurora's vitality and create a more livable, walkable downtown.

At this public open house, Aurora's draft downtown master plan will be available for public review and comment before beginning the formal review process with the City Council. From 4:00 to 6:00 p.m., the event will use an open house format that allows attendees to learn about the downtown master plan and provide input at their own pace. At 6:00 p.m., Mayor Richard C. Irvin will share his remarks, followed by an open dialogue discussion with participants. Representatives from the City and CMAP will be available to gather feedback, answer questions, and provide clarification.

Local residents, business owners, community leaders, and other interested stakeholders are encouraged to attend this exciting community planning event. Light refreshments will be provided.


