Re: ON TO 2050 Update

The CMAP Board and committees receive regular detailed updates on the various components of ON TO 2050 plan development that are most relevant to them. Since the volume of work associated with plan development is too large for every committee to learn about every component individually, this bi-monthly memo provides a brief status update on all major ongoing elements of plan development, including links to recent presentations and interim or final products when available. The public engagement activities are supported and amplified by coordinated print materials and extensive social media output, using the #2050BigIdeas hashtag thread on <u>Twitter</u> and <u>Facebook</u> .
