

Vision for the IIPD



Serve as a National Multimodal Freight & Logistics Hub

Maintain the IIPD's status as a national multimodal freight & logistics hub by pursing investments that will further position the IIPD to handle additional freight volumes by barge/vessel, rail, pipeline, and highway modes



Facilitate Economic Development on the Southeast Side

Facilitate economic development in Southeast Side Chicago by increasing industrial, commercial, and recreational land utilization at underutilized Port properties



Enhance Quality of Life and Community Benefits

Enhance quality of life of surrounding community by mitigating the negative impacts of freight and industry, and improving the community's ability to connect with each other and with nature in Calumet Gateway and Square Marsh



West District


- Multimodal freight facility by expanding road, rail, and water access






Proposed Access

- Repair/replace existing sheds
- Upgrade and expand port entrance





Strategy A: Financial Stability and Opportunity for Increased Revenue

Improve IIPD's financial stability and secure opportunities for increased revenue.

- Port boundary survey
- Current & future tenant lease assessment
- Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for partial infill of Finger Piers







Strategy B: Port Modernization – Operations

Upgrade and modernize IIPD's operational capabilities, improve data & recordkeeping practices.

- Expand data collection practices
- Staff augmentation & professional services support
- Technology & systems investments
- Broadband & 5G connectivity evaluation
- Feasibility of renewable energy power generation at IIPD







Strategy C: Port Modernization – Infrastructure

Upgrade and modernize physical infrastructure, including road, rail, and port facilities and utilities.

- Rehabilitate and modernize critical port infrastructure at Iroquois Landing, West District, and South District
- Comprehensive structural and infrastructure condition assessment







Strategy D: Improve Quality of Environmental Assets

Improve conditions at the IIPD's naturalized areas throughout Lake Calumet and on Lake Michigan.

- Coordinate on all restoration activities in Lake Calumet Area, incl. Square Marsh & Big Marsh
- Align proposed restoration activities with efforts at federal, state, regional, and local levels
- Feasibility study for treatment wetlands and other naturebased infrastructure within Lake Calumet







Strategy E: Community Access and Destination Amenities

Provide increased community access for residents of Southside Chicago and destination amenities for the greater Calumet region.

- Move TWIC boundary and fences south of Calumet Gateway
- Issue RFPs for Calumet Gateway
- Seek developer/operator for boathouse at Calumet Gateway
- Seek developer/operator for RV park facility at North Finger Pier
- Support development of multi-use path
- Feasibility study for blue-ways trail







Strategy F: Improved Access to Industrial Facilities

Improve road, rail, and waterway access to IIPD industrial facilities.

- Navigational assessment for Lake Calumet
- Bathymetric surveys of Port waterways
- Rail feasibility study for West & South Districts
- BCA and feasibility of vehicle bridge connecting Stony Island Ave to 130th St.







Strategy G: Port as a Good Neighbor & Leader

Improve IIPD's public perception and become a community leader and environmental steward.
