Re: FY 2014 UWP Competitive Proposals

On January 3, 2013 a Call for Projects was made for the FY 2014 UWP proposals. Nine proposals were received for the core projects and eighteen for the competitive projects. At its meeting on February 28, the UWP Committee tentatively approved the core proposals at \$14,585,470.

At the meeting on March 7 the sponsoring agencies will present their proposals at the meeting. The Committee members will rank the proposals by March 13. Based on the available monies after the Core proposals have been funded, CMAP staff will incorporate the Committee's rankings and make a proposed program recommendation to the UWP Committee that follows the same considerations in the Core program. The following table reflects the competitive proposals received.

The total federal FY 2014 UWP funds available for distribution are \$16,837,254, with a tentative approval of the core projects there will be \$2,251,784 available for the competitive projects.
