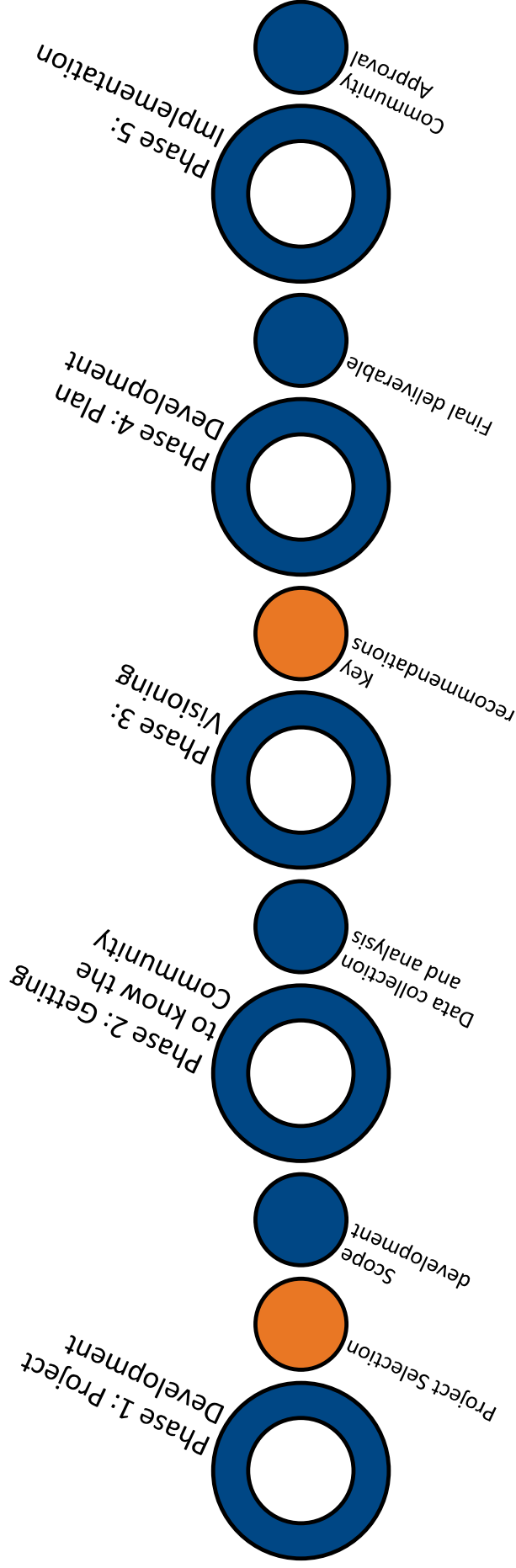
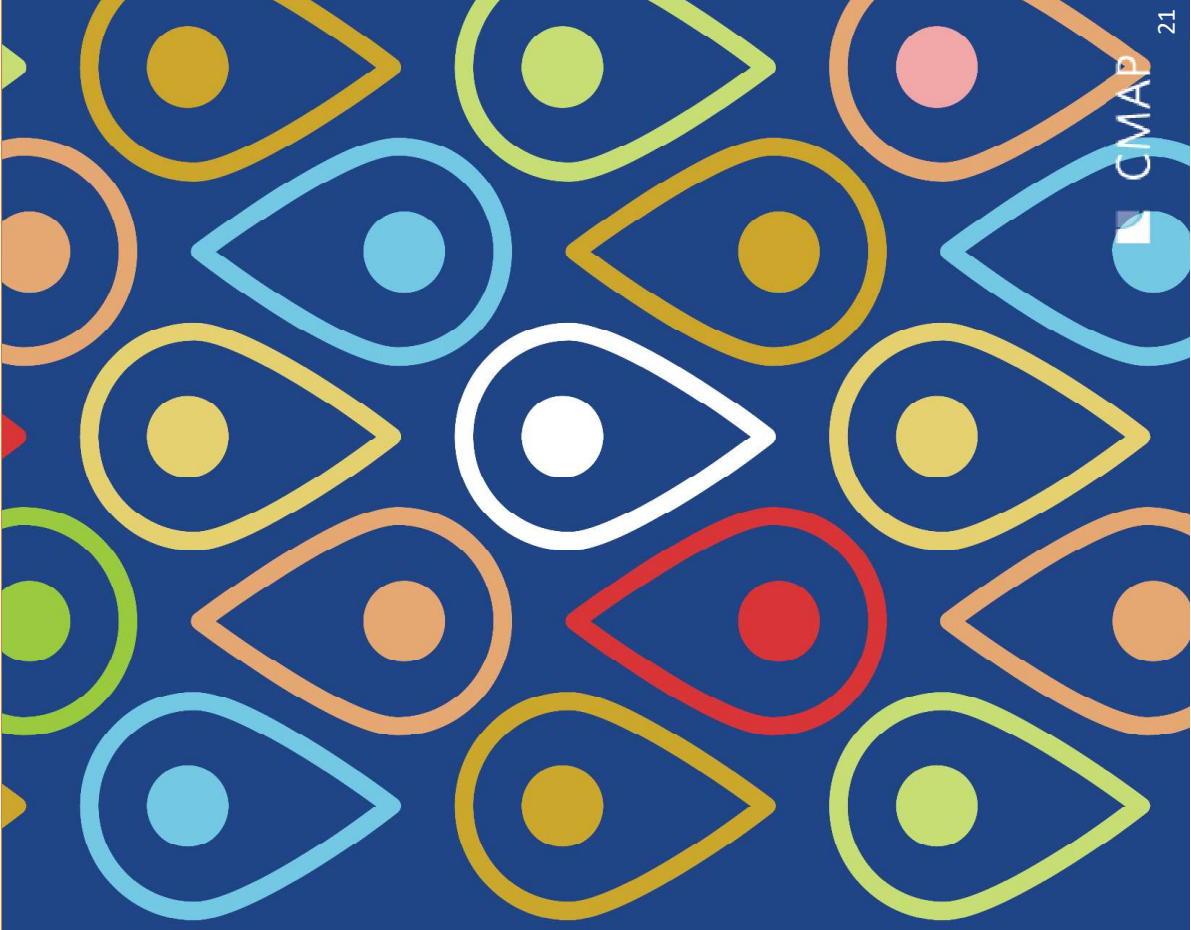

## Getting to know the community:

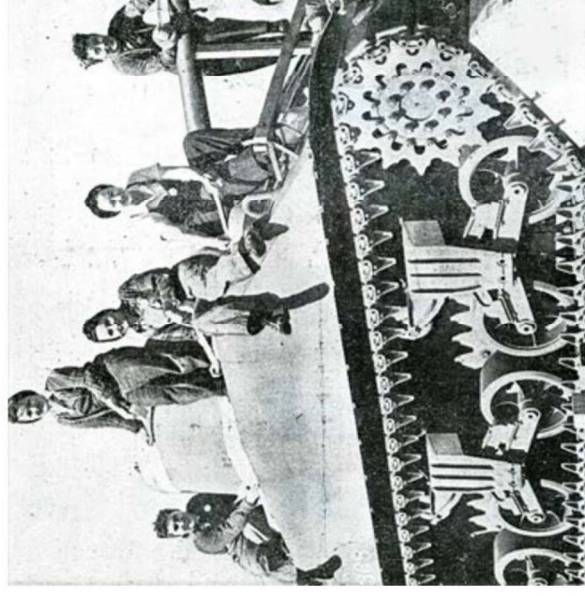
- Chicago's "forgotten" (or hidden) neighborhood

# Algonquin-Cary Subarea Plan

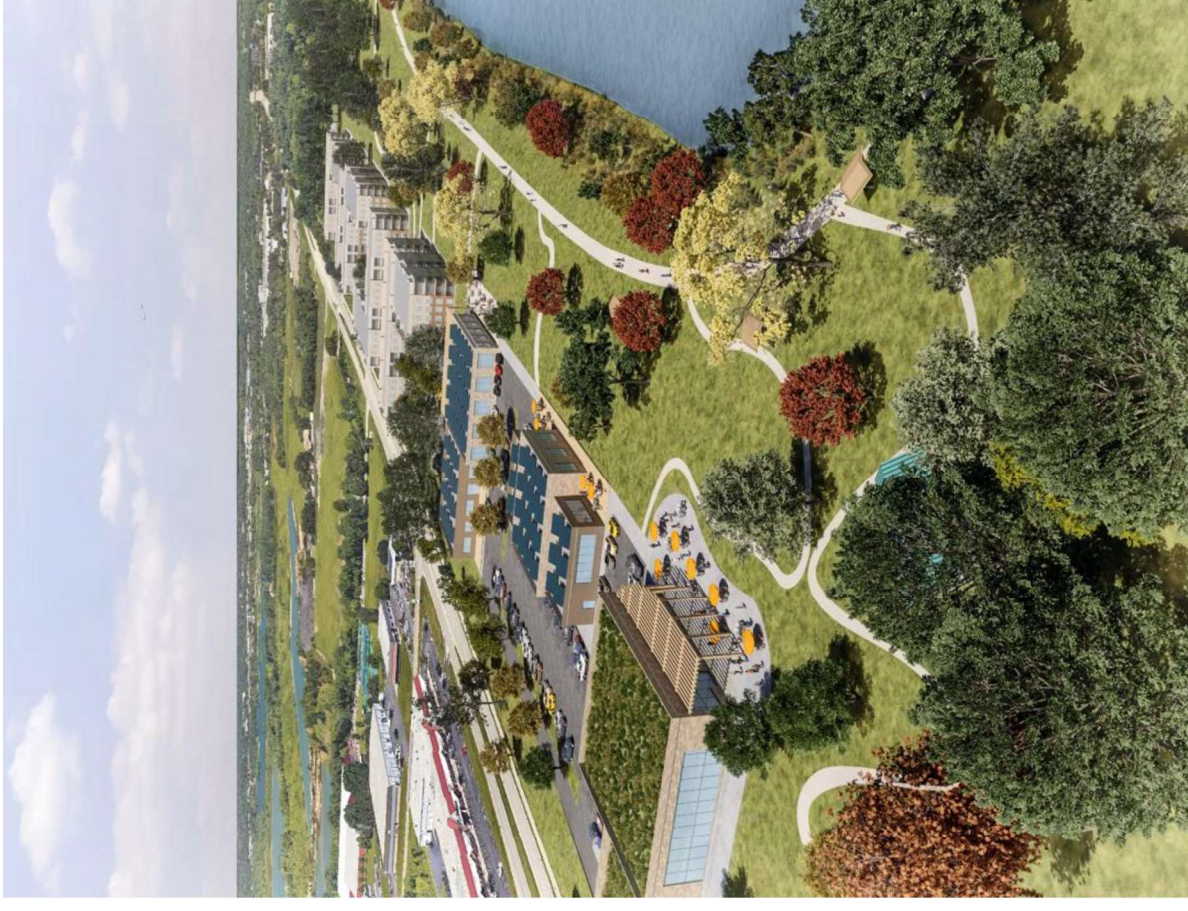
Multi-jurisdictional subarea plan
