

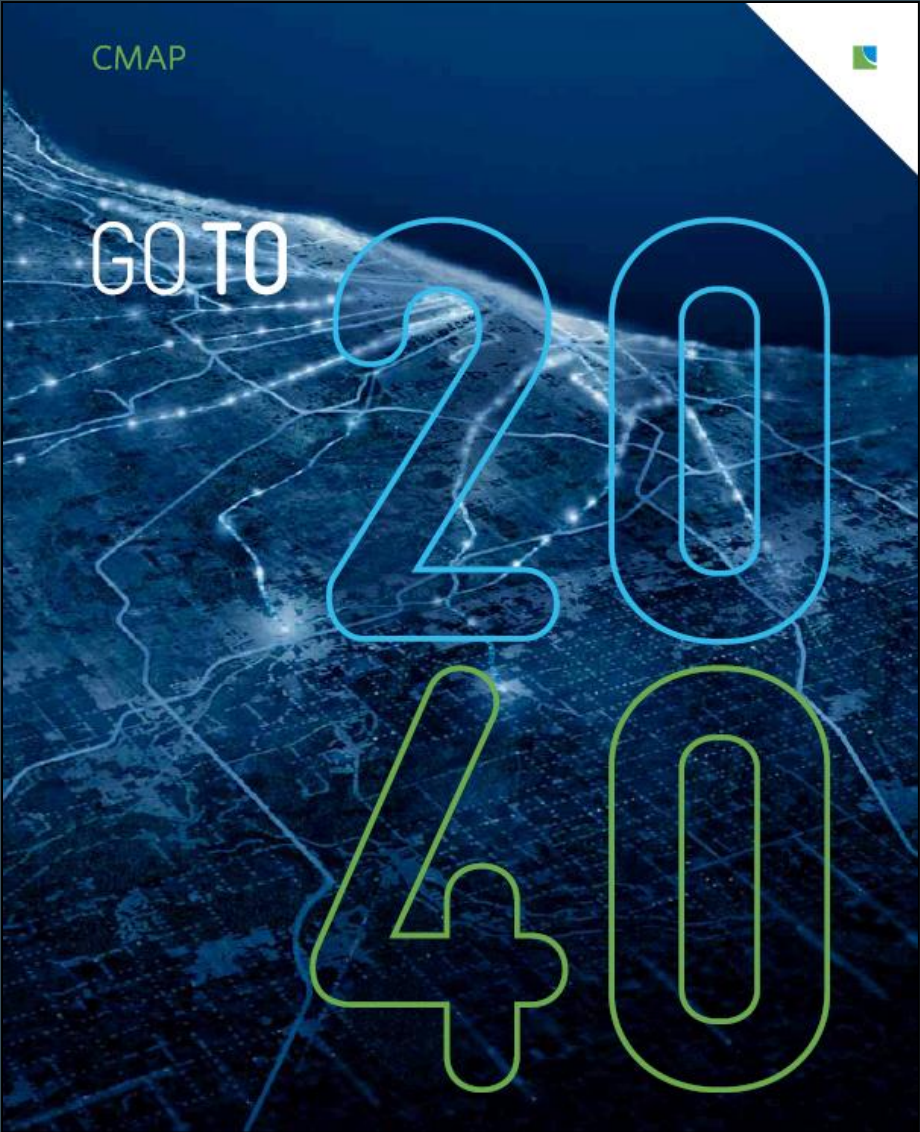

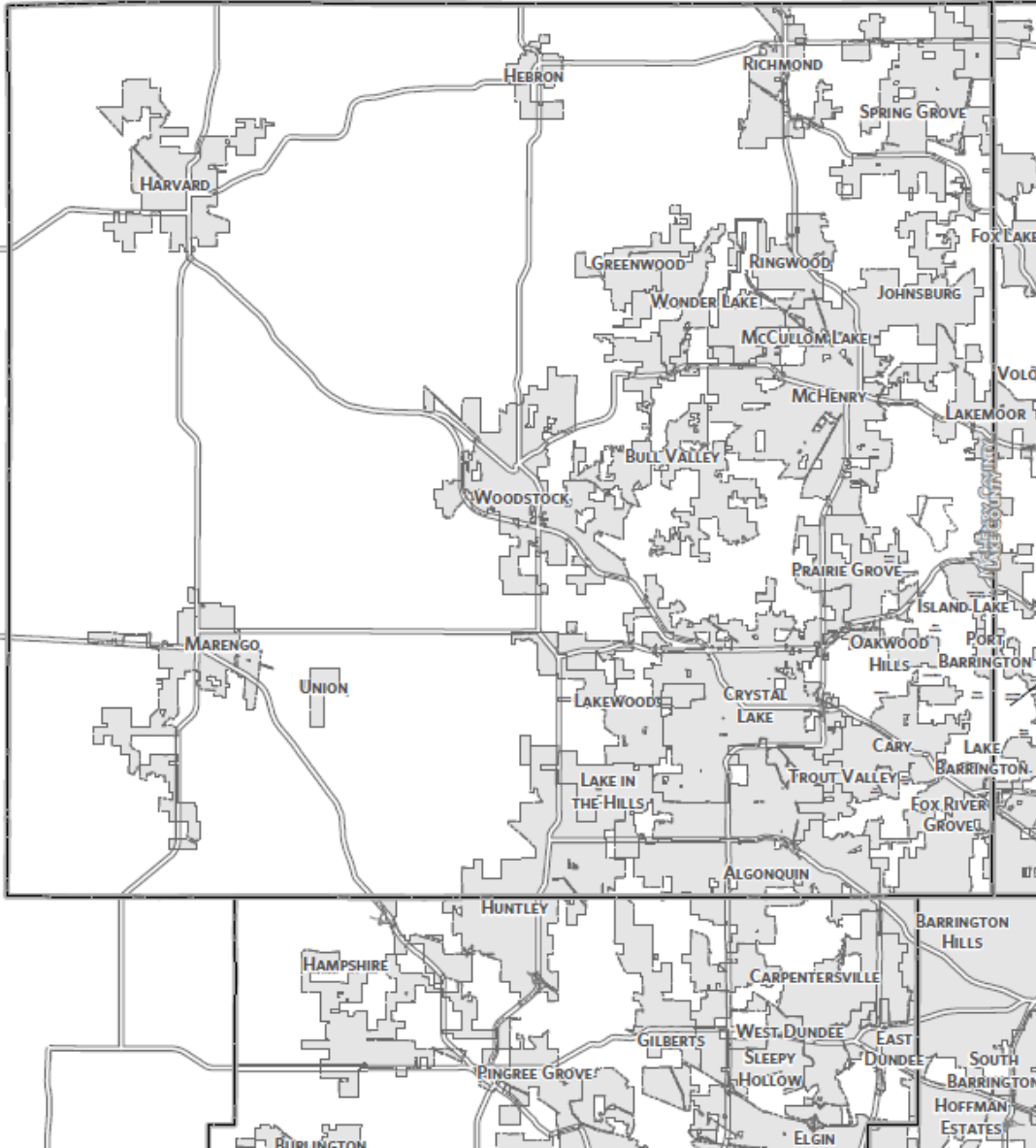
Coordinated Investment Studies

Help local governments find opportunities to collaborate on public infrastructure and services



McHenry County CIS

- Initiated by McHenry County and MCCOG
- Advisory Committee of 9 municipal partners and McHenry County Conservation District
- More than just road salt!



Project Timeline

- Project Initiation (Oct. 2018-Feb. 2019)
- Assessment of Local Government Services, Assets, and Procurements (Mar.-Aug. 2019)
- Development of Recommendations Memo (Sep.-Dec. 2019)
- Development of Coordinated Investment Study (Jan.-Apr. 2020)
- Study Adoption (May-Jun. 2020)
- Implementation (Beginning Jul. 2020)
