




## FY2019 TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS BY FUNDING SOURCE






- County Line Road and North Avenue at I-294— \$25.0M (\$30M)

- 75th Street CREATE Corridor Improvement Project-\$5M (\$77.7M)





#### COUNTY LINE ROAD & NORTH AVENUE AT I-294

- Delivered in partnership with the DuPage County, Illinois Tollway, IDOT, City of Elmhurst, and City of Northlake
- Eliminates Traffic Bottlenecks
- Reduces local flooding




- 134<sup>th</sup> Street—Halsted to Marsden Drive (Riverdale), \$64K




