LAND USE & HOUSING COMMITTEE (LUHC) 2019 Committee Charge

The Land Use and Housing Committee (LUHC) plays an important role helping the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) implement the ON TO 2050 plan. At the first meeting, members identified shared priorities for the 2019 calendar year. Among the roles and responsibilities outlined below, the committee's primary focus in 2019 will be on identifying and understanding key regional trends, needs, and solutions.

Roles and Responsibilities

The CMAP Land Use and Housing working committee works to:

- Help staff identify and understand key regional trends, needs, and solutions related to housing and land use.
- Coordinate and prioritize policy positions, programs, and approaches between CMAP and other regional stakeholders.
- Serve as a discussion forum that promotes exchange on best practices and encourages their adoption.
- Provide advisory feedback to CMAP staff and the Coordinating Committee on work related to land use and housing.
- Assist in implementing ON TO 2050 throughout the region.

Membership Terms

LUHC members must be full-time residents of the CMAP service area, which includes the counties of Cook, DuPage, Kane, Kendall, Lake, McHenry, and Will. Members will be selected to ensure diverse representation of geography, gender, age, race, ethnicity, and experience. Members may represent the nonprofit, public, or private sectors and may not have a material financial interest in the work of CMAP or its partners.

- 2-year terms of services. By defining renewable terms of service, we build in a time to periodically assess members' engagement and interest in continued participation.
- Rotating Chair and Vice Chair. The committee Chair and Vice Chair position will rotate
 through the committee to create opportunities for leadership among those who are
 interested.
- Attendance. CMAP requests members attend a minimum of two-thirds of the scheduled meetings in person, or four out of six annual meetings. If members are unable to attend, it is desired that they send a substitute who can speak to the agenda items.
- *Filling vacancies*. CMAP staff will determine membership updates due to job change on a case-by-case basis.

2019 Meeting Dates

The LUHC meets 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. on the second Tuesday of most months. The 2019 schedule is: March 5, May 7, July 2, September 3, and November 5.
