Stories of exploration - LaSalle's expedition of 1679 through Illinois country to the Kankakee River and then on to the Mississippi.



#### **ROUTE 66 LACK OF IDENTITY ON INTERSTATE 80**






### **Getting Around the Corridor**








## ROUTE 66 BRAIDWOOD STOP IDEAS: LARGE FISH SCULPTURE

























## Imagine the Possibilities.

A family wakes up early one Saturday and heads for the train station. This is no ordinary Saturday – today, the parents will unwind in a real Midwestern Prairie, and the kids will learn about food and history, while getting some exercise. As the Metra train reaches the last stop at Manhattan, the kids jump down and run for the bike show station, impatient to get on the Wauponsee Trail their friends have been praising. The trail is cool, with the summer sun poking through the thick leaves of the trees. The empty bike haskets fill everyone with anticipation.

The weekend is measured not in hours, but in accomplishments: farmfresh egg omelets with fresh herbs at a local farm; a long hike through the Midowin Prairie; a rewarding picnic of freshlybaked bread and locally-produced meats along the clear waters of Prairie Creek; fishing for the first time at the Kankukee River; a visit to the new Museum of Agriculture, and a good right's size; at the local bed and breakfast.

To continue exploring this becauseful land, the family rents an electric car from the local car share and heads for the Summerfest Parade in Historic Emidwood. By now, the kids are huge fam of the Route 66 story, and want to see every 66 attraction nearby. Wilmington's Gemini Giant becomes their now, tall family friend. A stop at the country's largest inland port in charming Elwood amages the kids – they have never seen so many enurmous containers before! The evening ends with a family musical at the gitty Rialtu in Joliet.
