The TAP program is a \$13.5 million program of bicycle facility projects that helps complete the Regional Greenways and Trails Plan. The proposed programs, approved by CMAP's Project Selection Committee on September 5, will go to the CMAP Board and MPO Policy Committee on October 10.
