

New sources of transportation revenue

Rebuild Illinois provides \$2.8 billion in annual state transportation revenues

State motor fuel tax

- Rate increased by 19 cents and indexed
- Diesel differential increased by 5 cents

Motor vehicle registration fees

- Increase of \$50 for passenger vehicles and \$100 for trucks
- Electric vehicles increased from \$17.50 to \$251


Increased certificate of title fees, salvage fees



Distribution of Illinois' 19-cent motor fuel tax increase



2019-2050, in billions








Gaming and casino expansion



State programs funded through Rebuild Illinois


Water Revolving Loan Fund

 \$200 million into the fund for both drinking water and water supply infrastructure

Open Space Investments

- \$10 million for the Natural Areas Acquisition Fund
- \$23 million for the Open Space Lands Acquisition and Development Fund
- \$25 million for the Open Lands Trust Fund
