

- Eliminate overall applications of pesticides contained in weed and feed products.
- Focus on practices that build healthy soil and dense turf.
 - Mow to 3 inches and leave clippings on the lawn.
 - Apply organic fertilizer and/or compost topdressing when needed.
 - Aerate and overseed in the fall.
- ✓ If you have a pest, follow Integrated Pest Management practices.
