This past funding cycle, projects were evaluated based on the percent of travelers using a facility that are people of color below the poverty line. Projects can receive a maximum of 10 points for supporting the inclusive growth principle. CMAP staff, Jesse

Elam, will review the inclusive growth evaluation criteria and discuss the impact it had on project selection outcomes and in supporting low income people of color.
