

Percent Assets Exceeding Useful Life






CURRENT ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES FOR CAPITAL PROGRAMMING

- CMAP, RTA, Service Boards have roles
- Projects move through three processes:
 - Regional Plans for long- and mid-term view
 - RTA Budget and Five-Year Regional Capital Program for near-term view
 - Ongoing RTA Capital Program Administration and Monitoring for construction



- **Communicate** the **Goals, Process, and Outcomes** of capital program in transparent, engaging way.
- Integrate regional goals into regional capital program development process to clarify linkages
- Implement three changes to current process:
 - Clarified Requirements & Goals
 - Improved Data Collection
 - Enhanced Information Products and Updates



NEXT STEPS

- Framework will be released for 45-day public comment July 15
- Investment Framework + comments incorporated into budget process currently underway
- Enhanced information products will be released throughout year
