5.0 CMAP analysis of essential worker demographics

Due to Governor Pritzker's Executive Order 20-10, CMAP looked at the 12 broad occupations classified as essential workers in metropolitan Chicago to identify who these workers are and where they live. CMAP research shows that essential workers from disadvantaged communities—particularly people of color and those who live in low-income communities—are playing critical roles in providing healthcare and keeping the transportation, food supply, and other essentials systems functioning during this crisis. Understanding these trends highlights the need for [collaborative efforts to address disparities](#) in economic opportunity. CMAP staff will provide an overview of trends that emerged from this research.
